



Regional, sub-regional and local gross value added 2009

Coverage: United Kingdom Theme: The Economy

Regional GVA (NUTS1)

Calculated on a workplace basis, London's gross value added (GVA) per head of population in 2008 was 69.5 per cent above the average for the United Kingdom (UK), while that of Wales was 25.7 per cent below the average. The 2008 headline estimates show that total GVA, at current basic prices, has been increasing in all UK regions.

Overall UK GVA growth (excluding the statistical discrepancy and Extra-Regio) in 2008 was 3.5 per cent. The highest growth was in Scotland (4.7 per cent), followed by London (4.1 per cent), the North West and the South West (both at 3.6 per cent). The lowest growth occurred in the South East, Northern Ireland, Wales and the West Midlands, with each increasing by 3.0 per cent.

Sub-regional GVA (NUTS2)

Within the 37 NUTS2 areas of the United Kingdom (mainly groups of counties), Inner London had the largest GVA per head on a workplace basis (£57,180) for 2007, the latest year for which estimates are available. West Wales and the Valleys had the lowest (£12,617). These figures compare with the UK average (excluding Extra-Regio) of £19,951.

Local GVA (NUTS3)

The 2007 estimates for the 133 NUTS3 areas (principally individual counties and unitary authorities) of the UK show Inner London - West had the largest GVA per head (£101,182) and Isle of Anglesey had the smallest (£10,998).

Regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates

GVA estimates are available for the 12 regions and countries of the UK plus Extra-Region (off-shore GVA that cannot be assigned to any region - see background note 7), 37 sub-regions (NUTS2) and 133 local areas (NUTS3). These estimates are consistent with the National Accounts Blue Book 2009.

Regional GVA estimates (NUTS1) for 2008 are being released for the first time along with revisions for the period 1989 to 2007. These estimates update those published in December 2008.

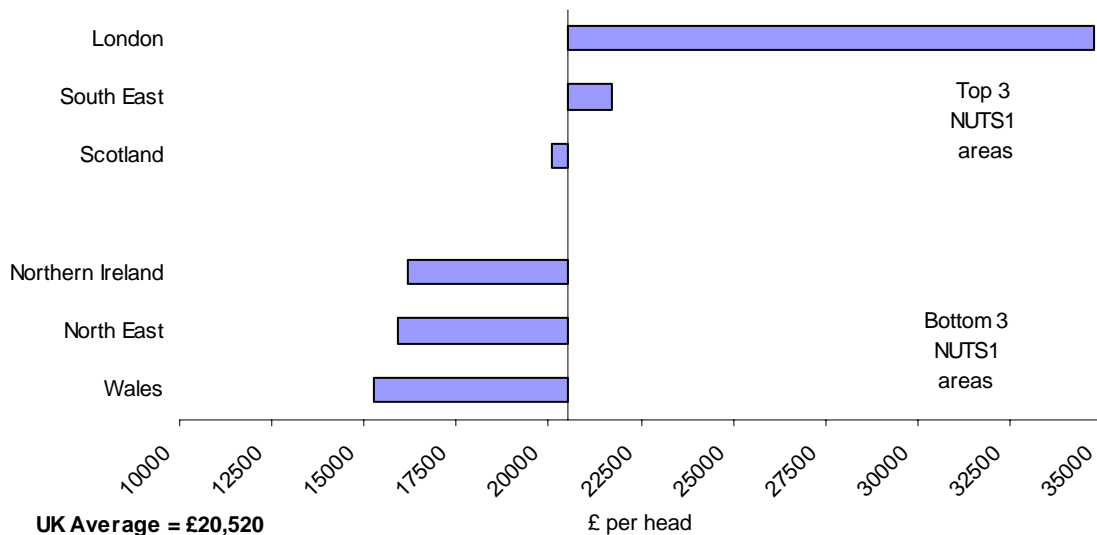
At the more detailed levels of geography (NUTS2 and NUTS3) estimates for 2007 are being released for the first time along with revisions for the period 1995 to 2006, updating the estimates published in December 2008.

Regional GVA estimates (1989 to 2008)

GVA per head of population

GVA per head of population for the UK as a whole, excluding Extra-Regio, was £20,520 in 2008. London had the highest GVA per head (£34,786) and that of the South East (£21,688) was also above the UK average. All other regions had a GVA per head value below the UK average. Wales had the lowest (£15,237), followed by the North East (£15,887) and Northern Ireland (£16,188). GVA per head increased in all regions compared with 2007.

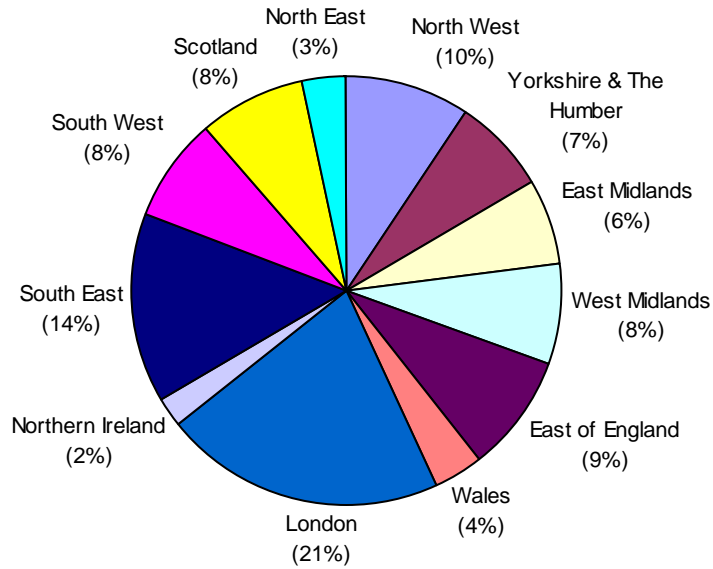
NUTS1 GVA per head comparison with UK average, 2008



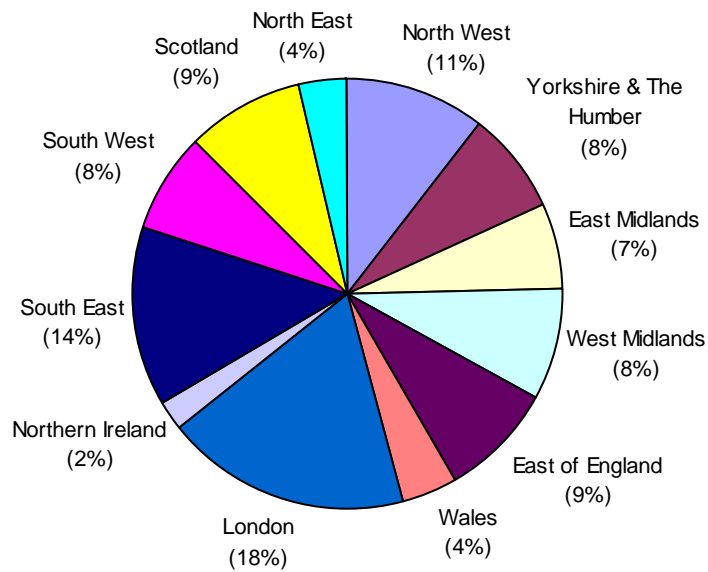
Shares of GVA

London and the South East had the largest share of total UK GVA in 2008 (21.0 per cent and 14.4 per cent respectively). The contributions of London and the South East to UK GVA have both increased since 1995, when they accounted for 18.2 per cent and 13.7 per cent respectively. Northern Ireland (2.3 per cent) and the North East (3.2 per cent) had the smallest share of UK GVA in 2008. The contribution of the North East has fallen since 1995, when it accounted for 3.7 per cent of UK GVA.

Regional shares of total GVA, 2008



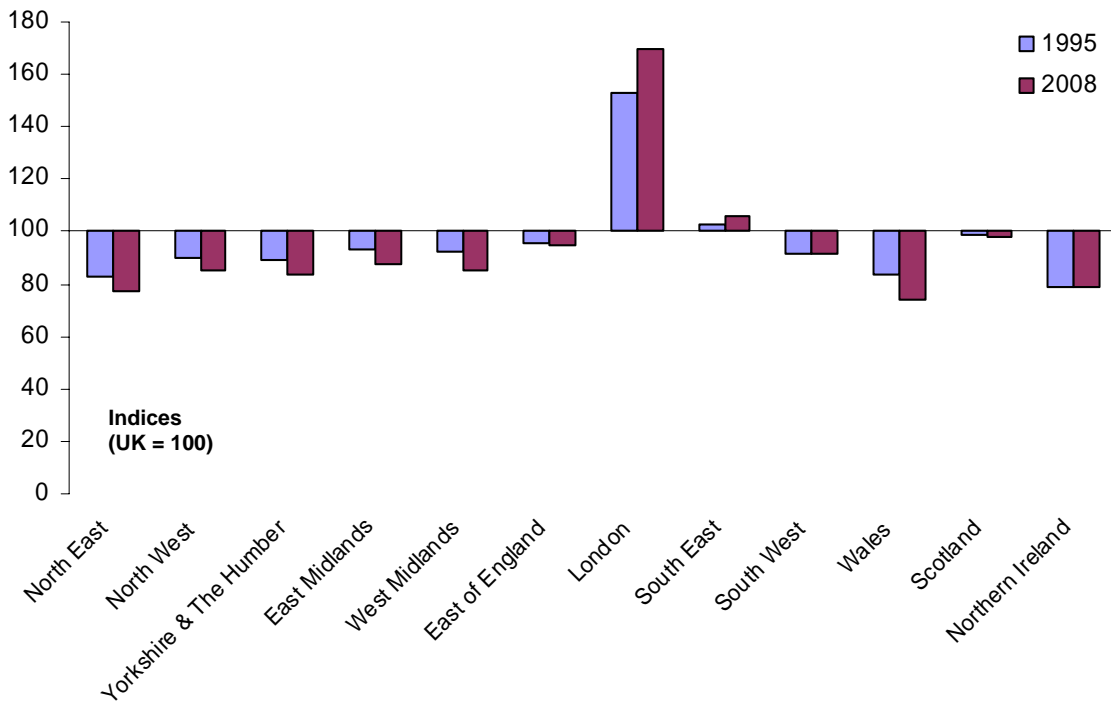
Regional shares of total GVA, 1995



GVA per head indices

Calculated on a workplace basis, London had the highest regional GVA per head of population index in 2008 (169.5), where UK=100. This compares with the 1995 estimate for London of 152.7. Wales had the lowest index (74.3), which compares with the 1995 estimate for Wales of 83.5.

Sub-regional and local GVA estimates (1995 to 2007)

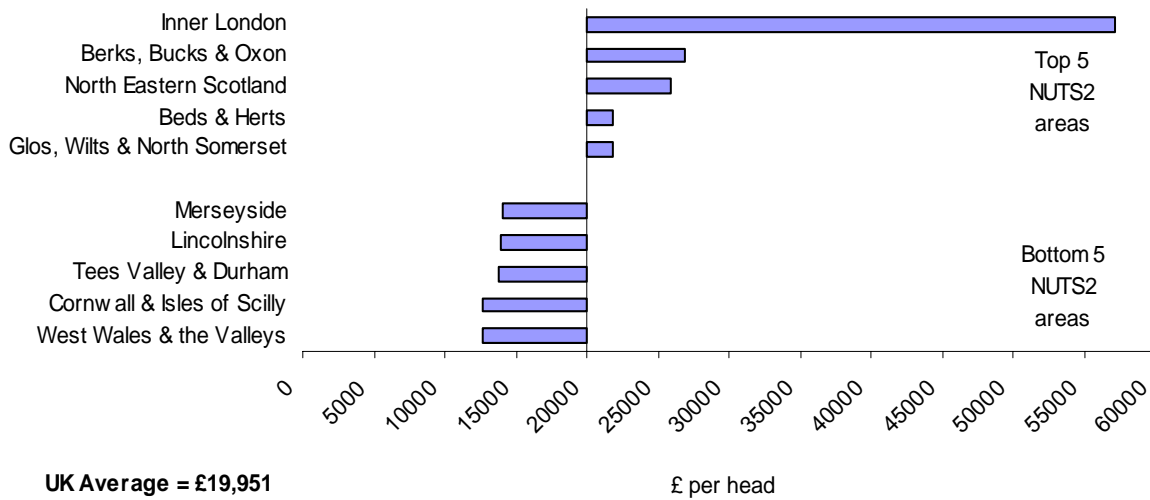
Growth rates of total GVA

Total GVA has been increasing in all UK NUTS2 and NUTS3 areas. Within NUTS2 areas, growth in total GVA between 2006 and 2007 was highest in Inner London (7.8 per cent) and East Anglia (6.8 per cent). The NUTS2 areas with the lowest growth between 2006 and 2007 in total GVA were Lancashire (3.8 per cent) and East Yorkshire and North Lincolnshire (4.1 per cent).

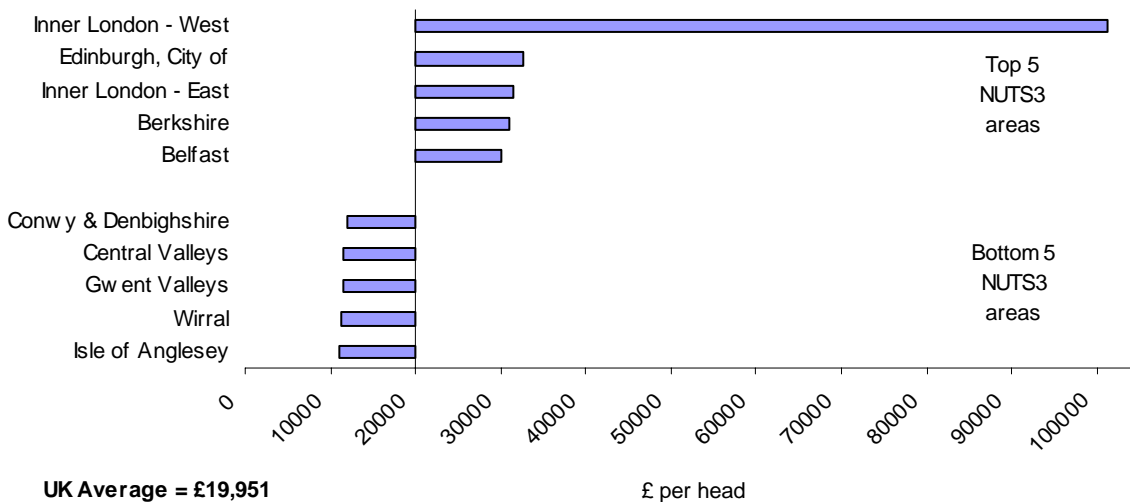
GVA per head of population

The NUTS2 areas with the highest GVA per head of population in 2007 were Inner London (£57,180), Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire (£26,847) and North Eastern Scotland (£25,855). Within NUTS2, the areas with the lowest GVA per head were West Wales and the Valleys (£12,617) Cornwall and Isles of Scilly (£12,681) and Tees Valley and Durham (£13,787).

The NUTS3 areas with the highest GVA per head in 2007 were Inner London - West (£101,182), City of Edinburgh (£32,697) and Inner London - East (£31,451). The NUTS3 areas with the lowest

GVA per head in 2007 were Isle of Anglesey (£10,998), Wirral (£11,257) and Gwent Valleys (£11,397). These estimates compare with the UK average GVA per head of £19,951 in 2007.

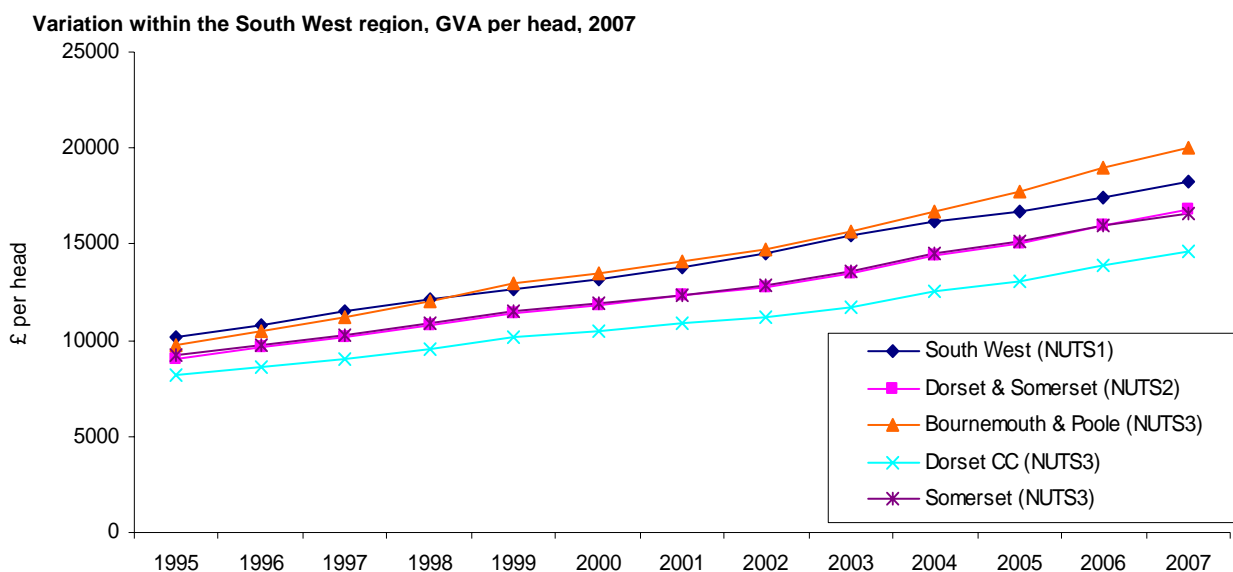
GVA per head indices

The NUTS2 area of Inner London had the largest GVA per head index in 2007 (286.6). In contrast, the GVA per head index for the NUTS2 area West Wales and the Valleys was the lowest at 63.2. Inner London - West had the largest GVA per head index within NUTS3 areas (507.1), while that of Isle of Anglesey (55.1) was the lowest.

Variation within NUTS geographies

Within the 12 regions and countries of the United Kingdom (NUTS1), the GVA per head of the constituent NUTS2 sub-regions and NUTS3 local areas can vary considerably. For example, the GVA per head of London in 2007 was £34,786; the GVA per head for the NUTS2 areas Inner London and Outer London were £57,180 and £18,229 respectively. Meanwhile the GVA per head for NUTS3 Inner London-West and Outer London-East & North East was £101,182 and £13,841 respectively.

Over time, differences in regional economic activity can become apparent, as illustrated in the NUTS2 sub-region of Dorset and Somerset. Looking at the constituent NUTS3 local areas, GVA per head has diverged since 1995, when Bournemouth and Poole, Dorset CC and Somerset all had similar GVA per head values, when compared with the GVA per head of Dorset and Somerset (NUTS2) and the corresponding NUTS1 region (the South West). Revisions

Revisions to regional GVA estimates in this release cover the period 1989 to 2007. Estimates at lower geographical levels are being revised for the period 1995 to 2006, with 1995 being the starting point of the NUTS2 and NUTS3 time series.

The main reasons for revisions are detailed below:

In the UK National Accounts Blue Book 2009, the totals for national GVA by industry were revised as far back as 2004. These lead to revisions in the regional data, which are constrained to the national figures.

PAYE data from Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC), used in the compilation of compensation of employees estimates, were revised for 2004/05, 2005/06 and 2006/07 and new estimates supplied for 2007/08.

Final estimates for 2007 became available from the Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings, Annual Business Inquiry and other data sources.

Future work plans

ONS plans to publish estimates of regional GVA for 1989 to 2009 and sub-regional and local GVA for 1995 to 2008 in December 2010. The publication of regional household income estimates for the period 1995 to 2008 is currently planned for March 2010.

The new Eurostat NACE Rev2 and its UK equivalent, the Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (UK SIC2007) will be implemented in the UK national accounts (and therefore GDP) in September 2011 (in line with EU regulation). This new classification will be implemented in the regional GVA estimates in December 2011, also in line with EU regulation.

Annex A: Diversity of the NUTS1 regions

Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Government Office Regions of England have differing demographic characteristics, industrial structure and economic performance. The table overleaf shows some of the differences.

Scotland has the largest area, but a relatively small population; London has by far the smallest area, but the second largest percentage of the population (12.4 per cent). At the other extreme, Northern Ireland has the smallest population at 2.9 per cent of the UK total. These large variations in the regions' populations are reflected in the size of regional GVA and incomes.

The wide variation in the size of the regions makes it difficult to compare the regions' economic performance using cash totals. Comparisons are therefore usually expressed in terms of amounts per head of the population. However, it is important to note that the growth in totals may be quite different from the growth per head in regions where the population has increased or decreased. Furthermore, the level per head is determined both by the average amount of income of the working population and by the proportion of the population who are economically inactive. Some regions will have a high proportion of children, which will tend to depress amounts per head. For productivity analysis the age structure of the population should be taken into account, when comparing figures on a per head basis (see background note 8).

Basic quality information

2. A Summary Quality Report for regional GVA can be found at www.statistics.gov.uk/about_ns/economicstatistics_qualityreports.asp. This report describes, in detail, the intended uses of the statistics presented in this publication, their general quality and the methods used to produce them.

Relevance to users

3. The Nomenclature of Units for Territorial Statistics (NUTS) provides a single uniform breakdown for the production of regional statistics for the European Union. There are three levels of NUTS in the UK:
 - NUTS1: Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Government Office Regions of England.
 - NUTS2: 37 areas – mainly groups of counties and unitary authorities; can be referred to as sub-regions.
 - NUTS3: 133 areas – principally individual counties and unitary authorities; also known as local areas.
 - Some areas appear at more than one level, for example Northern Ireland appears at NUTS1 and NUTS2 level.
4. The NUTS1 GVA estimates presented here are on a workplace basis (allocated to where the economic activity takes place). Residence based estimates, where earnings of individuals are allocated to the region in which they live, are also published at NUTS1 level.
5. Estimates are presented in current basic prices, in other words, they do not allow for different regional price levels or changes in prices over time (inflation).
6. The headline regional GVA series have been calculated using a 5-year, weighted moving average technique. These adjusted series remove some year to year volatility in the unadjusted series. The unadjusted series are also provided for information on the National Statistics website: <http://www.statistics.gov.uk/statbase/Product.asp?vlnk=14650>

7. The contribution to GVA of UK embassies abroad and UK forces stationed overseas is included in Extra-Regio, along with the elements relating to activities taking place on the continental shelf. As these cannot be assigned to specific regions they are assigned as Extra-Regio GVA. The statistical discrepancy is the difference between the sum of the national income components and the definitive national estimate of GVA.
8. GVA per head is a useful way of comparing regions of different sizes and is an important indicator for both domestic and European policy purposes. It is not, however, a measure of regional productivity, as the population estimates used to calculate it include the economically inactive population. The ONS does produce estimates of regional GVA per filled job and GVA per hour worked in the Productivity Statistical Bulletin. Common pitfalls in interpreting series

9. Very few statistical revisions arise as a result of 'errors' in the popular sense of the word. All estimates, by definition, are subject to statistical 'error' but, in this context, the word refers to the uncertainty in any process or calculation that uses sampling, estimation or modelling. Most revisions reflect either the adoption of new statistical techniques or the incorporation of new information which allows the statistical error of previous estimates to be reduced. Only rarely are there avoidable 'errors' such as human or system 'errors' and such mistakes are made clear when they are discovered and corrected.

Accuracy

10. Figures for 2008 are provisional and data for all years are subject to revisions in light of revised National Accounts Blue Book data in future years.

Reliability

11. As with the national accounts, regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates are calculated as reliably as possible. There is no easy way to measure the reliability of the estimates but ONS carries out consistency checks on data inputs, applies methods consistently and makes use of local knowledge for England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. The estimates are partly based on sample surveys and the quality of the results therefore varies according to sample size. This means that the results for smaller regions are subject to a greater degree of uncertainty than those for larger regions. Revisions to

GVA estimates for the latest previously published year (2007), are shown in the following table.
