FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT AT THE GAMES OF THE IXTH OLYMPIAD, AMSTERDAM 1928

The Official Report of the Games of the IXth Olympiad, Amsterdam 1928, does not give full details about the various matches that were played in the football/soccer-, the fieldhockey- and waterpolo-tournaments.

The report only gives the final result, the halftime score, the names of the players and the names of the referee and the two linesmen of each match. No date is mentioned, no time of the day, and not even the place where the match was played. And for many of us, the important thing to know will be the names of the players who scored the goals, and how the score in each match developed!

The point where the various matches were played is not that important, because all matches, except one, were played in the Olympic Stadium.

From contemporary reports in newspapers, sport-magazines, etc., I have been able to reconstruct the development of each match, the time each match was played and where, and finally the names from the player (and in many cases the time at which) the goals were scored. The list underneath will give the result of my research!

Another thing which came to the fore was the illogical sequence used in the Official Report, which was not conforming to the sequence in which the matches were played. The sequence in the report must have been chosen at random. My list gives the matches in the sequence in which they were played.
