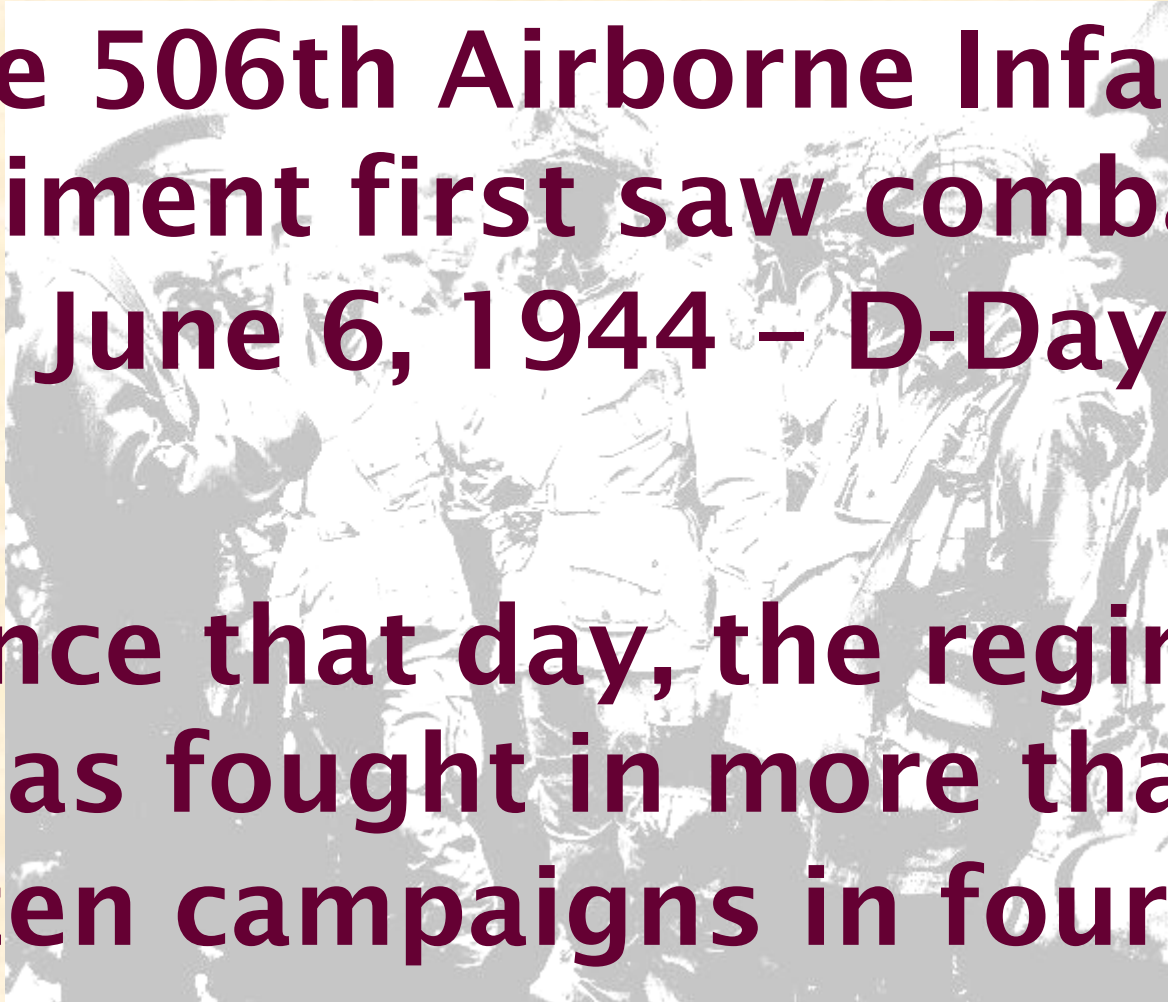


# In remembrance of fallen 'Currahees'



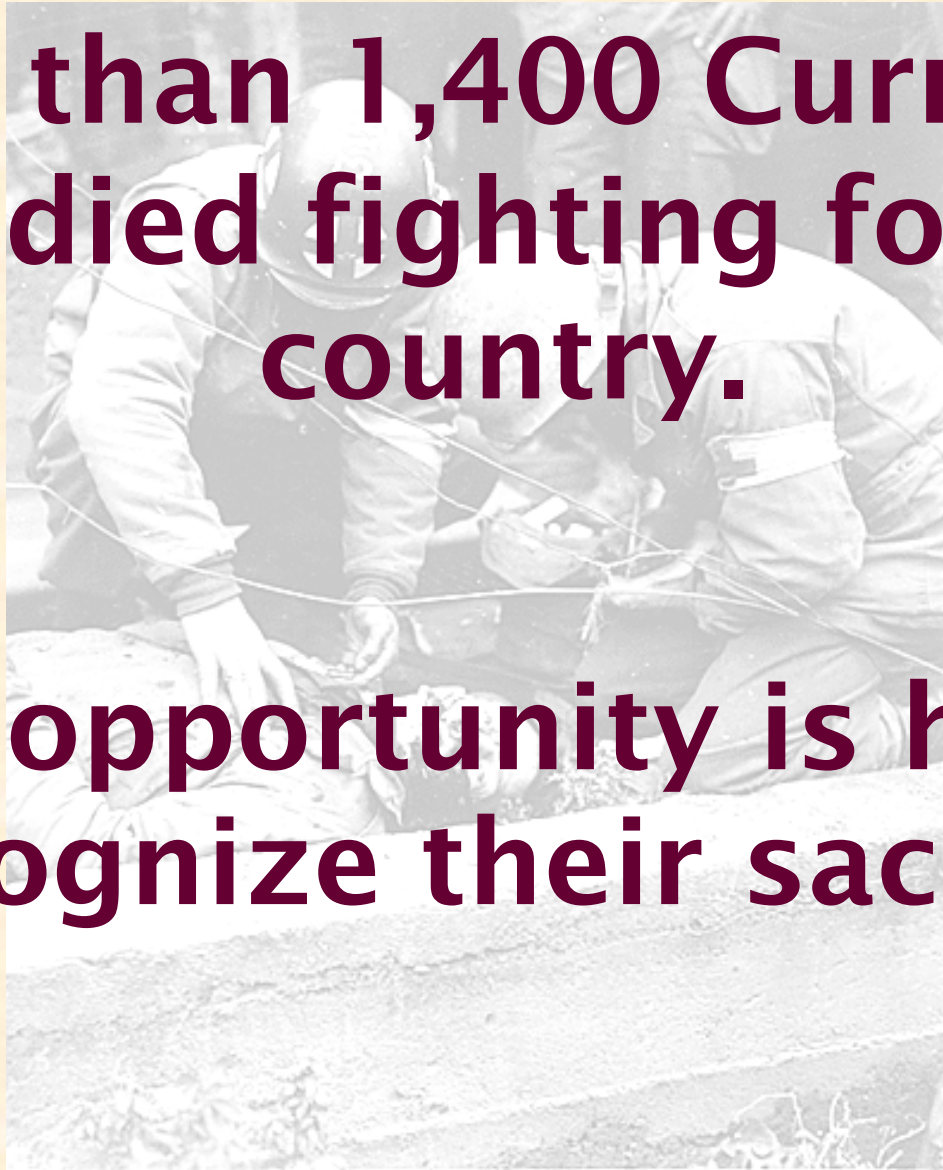
**The 506th Airborne Infantry

June 6, 1944 – D-Day.**


**Since that day, the regiment

country.**

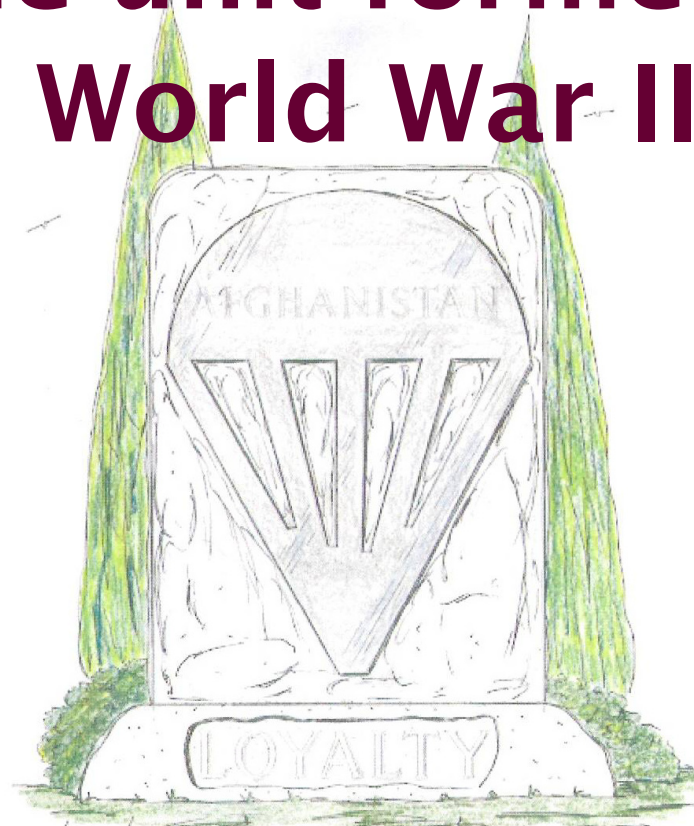
**The opportunity is here to
