# WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN THE GAME/QUOI SURVEILLER DANS LE MATCH

Toronto is **6-1-0** in its last seven **home games** and **7-2-0** in its last nine home games.

Toronto is 5-1-0 in home games against East Division opponents dating back to 2007.

Last season, the Argos won the head-to-head season series against the Als for the first time since 2005. They split four games at two wins each but the Argos outscored Montreal 91 PF, 81 PA.

The Argos are **4-6-0** in their last 10 games **at Rogers Centre against Montreal**, but the Argos have **outscored** Montreal **246 PF**, **233 PA** in those ten games.

19 of the past 22 regular season match-ups between Toronto and Montreal have been decided by **7 or more points**. 10 of the past 22 regular season contests between the two clubs have been decided by **at least 20 points**.

The **Als** have won **17 of the past 25** regular season match-ups against Toronto dating back to 2000.

The team **leading after the first half** has won **9 of the past 10** contests between these two clubs.

Toronto's defence has allowed **opposing offences** (offensive majors and kicking points only) to score 30 or more points in a game **just seventeen times**, the fewest in the CFL since 2003. Perhaps more noteworthy, the Argonauts have held opposing offences to less than 20 offensive points on **fifty-two occasions**, the most in the CFL, since 2003.

# THE ARGOS FACE THE EAST DIVISION

This game marks the **third** of **six straight games** for the Argos **against East Division opponents**. The Boatmen take on Montreal, followed by Hamilton for the Labour Day Classic, Montreal, and finally at home against Winnipeg before meeting their first western opponent on **September 20** (Calgary).

# INDIVIDUALS/ INDIVIDUELLES

Entering CFL Week 8, RB/KR **Dominique Dorsey** was **first** in the CFL for most combined yards with 1,376. He's averaging **196.6 combined yards/game** and and is on pace to accumulate nearly **3,538 total yards** this season. If he continues at this pace, he'll accumulate the **third-highest single-season combined yards total** in **CFL history** and the **second-highest total** in **club history**.

This will be OT **Ross Weaver's** last game as an Argo as he has been recalled to active duty by the United States Air Force. He will report to **Francis E. Warren Air Force Base** in **Wyoming** and join the **321<sup>st</sup> Missile Squadron** on **August 19**. **First Lieutenant** Weaver was granted leave by the Air Force and they have since determined that his area of expertise (nuclear weapons/missile training) is necessary for the foreseeable future. He has completed 2 years of his required 5 years of service and must now complete the remaining three years as per the Air Force.

Last week in Hamilton, **Richie Williams** became the first quarterback to throw **three touchdown passes** in a regular season game against the Argos since **Anthony Calvillo** on **October 22**, **2005** in Montreal.

In his last **4 games** against Toronto, **Anthony Calvillo** has thrown **four interceptions** and just **three touchdown** passes.

In Anthony Calvillo's past five games against Toronto, he has been sacked 16 times.

Since the start of 2006 (4 games), **Kerry Joseph** has averaged **250 yards** passing per game, thrown **4 interceptions**, and **6 touchdowns**.

Just five times in the **past 85 games**, an opposing QB has thrown for more than **400 yards** against the Argonauts. Once per year seems to be Toronto's quota. For a complete list, please see the table below:

# **GAMES PLAYED**

**Mike O'Shea** (194) is now 3rd all-time on the Argos' games played list. He needs to dress in the remaining 11 games to overtake All-Time Argo **Danny Nykoluk** for 2<sup>nd</sup> place this season.

**Chad Folk** (184) is 6th all-time, and needs to play in 3 games to overtake Argos' CEO **Michael Clemons** for fifth all-time.

**Jude St. John** (172) is now 8th all-time and needs to play in 4 games to move into sole possession of 7th place ahead of **Dan Ferrone** (175).

# CAREER CONVERT ATTEMPTS

**Mike Vanderjagt** (148) needs 57 converts to surpass the legendary **Zenon Andrusyshyn** for third place all-time.

**Mike Vanderjagt** (148 straight over 42 games) has never missed a convert as an Argo. His streak has continued into 2008 and he **needs just 1** to surpass **Noel Prefontaine** for the third longest streak in club history.

# **CAREER FIELD GOAL ATTEMPTS**

**Mike Vanderjagt** (121) is 4th all-time for most field goals attempted in club history. He is well behind third all-time **Noel Prefontaine** (282).

# **CAREER FIELD GOALS**

**Mike Vanderjagt** (89) is fourth all-time in field goals scored and needs 92 to tie **Zenon Andrusyshyn** for third all-time.

# **CAREER KICKOFFS**

**Mike Vanderjagt** (227) is fifth all-time for most kickoffs behind All-Time Argo **Lance Chomyc** (347).

# **CAREER KICKOFF YARDS**

Mike Vanderjagt (13,321) is 5,256 yards behind All-Time Argo Lance Chomyc (18,577) for fourth most all-time.

# **CAREER KICKOFF SINGLES**

**Mike Vanderjagt** (4) is third all-time in kickoff singles. He is three behind **Zenon Andrusyshyn** (6) for second all-time.

# **RECEIVING**

**Arland Bruce III** has caught a pass in **47 consecutive games** he's dressed in as an Argo. The streak dates back to **September 5, 2005 vs Hamilton** and ties him with All-Time Argo **Dick Shatto** for the sixth-longest streak in club history. He is 10 games from passing All-Time Argo **Paul Masotti** (56) for fifth all-time.

# CAREER INTERCEPTIONS

Orlondo Steinauer (49) is within reach of tying CFL legends Ed Learn, Andre Francis, Glen Suitor and Paul Bennett (all at 51), for eighth on the all-time interceptions list.



**Orlondo Steinauer** (31) is 5th all-time for career interceptions, just 7 behind All-Time Argo **Carl Brazley** (37) for sole possession of 4th all-time.

# **CAREER INTERCEPTION YARDS**

**Orlondo Steinauer** (710) is in third place for most career interception yards, just 41 behind his former teammate **Adrion 'Pee Wee' Smith** (750) for 2<sup>nd</sup> place all-time.

**Byron Parker** (529) is in 5<sup>th</sup> place for most career interception return yards. He is just 40 yards from surpassing All-Time Argo **Don Wilson** (568) for fourth all-time.

# CAREER QUARTERBACK SACKS

**Jonathan Brown** (46) is now second all-time in club history for most career sacks. He is well behind **Rodney Harding** (92) for number one all-time.

## **CAREER DEFENSIVE TACKLES**

**Mike O'Shea** is in 2<sup>nd</sup> place on the CFL's all-time chart for Defensive Tackles. O'Shea currently sits at **1,112 for his career**, and is the only Canadian player in CFL history to reach the 1000+ club. He is in second place ahead of **Alondra Johnson (1,084 tackles)** and behind **Willie Pless (1,241 tackles)**.

**Kevin Eiben** (461) is third all-time in career defensive tackles and needs **41 tackles** to overtake All-Time Argo **Don Moen** (503) for second-most in club history.

**Orlondo Steinauer** (438) is fifth all-time, and needs just **10 tackles** to overtake All-Time Argo **Reggie Pleasant** (447) for fourth place all-time.

# **ARGOS TO WATCH**

# **OFFENCE**

**QB Kerry Joseph** – Threw for his second 300+ yard passing game as an Argo last week in Hamilton. Joseph had a tremendous first half running sideline to sideline and making exceptional plays with his feet and arm.

RB Dominique Dorsey – He is now averaging 196 combined yards in each of the first seven games. He scored his second offensive touchdown of the season last week while accumulating almost 150 all purpose yards. Dorsey is doing something no one else in the CFL is - starting on offence (running back) and handling virtually all of the kick return duties.

**Reggie McNeal** – Made his CFL debut last week and dressed as a receiver. He was the Argos' leading ball catcher and finished with a remarkable 6 grabs for 101 yards.

**RB Jamal Robertson** – Scored his third touchdown of the season against the Tiger-Cats last week and although he collected just 15 rushing yards, they were yards that mattered.

**WR Andre Talbot** – Has led his team in each of the last two games with 6 and 7 receptions respectively. Consistently puts his team in excellent field position and caught for 96 yards last week.

# **DEFENCE**

**DE Jonathan Brown** – Recorded his fifth sack of the season last week, the fourth-highest total in the CFL entering Week 8, while also adding 2 tackles.



**DB Kenny Heatly** – Started and played the entire game in Hamilton last week at wide-side DB making 5 DT. He's fast, smart and athletic; watch for Heatly to show great improvement as the season rolls on.

LB Willie Pile – Has been one of the most consistent Argos this season. Last week he made 5 DT, 3 ST tackles, recorded his first QB sack of the season and knocked down a pass.

**QB Marcus Brady (2002-03)** – Played 23 games for Toronto as a key backup for Damon Allen, Reggie Slack and Michael Bishop. Brady completed 32 of 91 passes for 582 yards, 5 TD and 6 INT as an Argo.

# **COACHES**

**Steve Buratto (1994-95)** – Buratto was the mastermind behind one of the most powerful offences in CFL history while winning a Grey Cup with the Baltimore Stallions in 1995. The Stallions, of course, moved to Montreal in 1996 and became the Alouettes. The 1994 season was the only other season (besides 2007 and 2008) that Buratto has coached in the East Division. **Miles Gorrell (1982-85)** – Gorrell played four seasons in Montreal and was among the distinguished alumni honoured during the Als' 2007 home pre-season game.

**NT Adriano Belli (2001-03, 06)** – Played 37 games for the Alouettes and amassed 34 DT, 6 sacks and 8 tackles for a loss. He also played in three Grey Cup championships with the Als.

**DL Jean-Nicolas Carriere** – A product of McGill University, Carriere was the Argos' third round selection in this year's draft. He lived across the street from Percival Molson Stadium while at school and says he used it as motivation to get himself to the pros.

WR Obed Cétoute - Grew up in Montreal and left to attend school at Central Michigan.

**DL Adrian Davis** – Attended Marshall University before transferring to Concordia in Quebec. Drafted in the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the 2006 CFL Draft by Montreal and released following 2007 training camp.

**DS Yves Hercule** – Grew-up in the province of Quebec and attended school at Laval University in Quebec City.
