

Alice In Wonderland Gloves

Designed By Kristin - Inspired by Tim Burton

Needles: US 5 straights

Yarn: (DK weight) 1 ball of Be Sweet Bamboo (115yds) in color A (white), 1 ball of Be Sweet Bamboo in color B (blue) Gauge: 5.5 sts per inch in stockinette

These gloves are knit flat & seemed up the side to get the perfect stripe.

With color A, cast on 42 sts.

Row 1: (WS) *P2, K2, repeat from *.

Row 2 & 3: Knit the knits & purls the purls.

Row 4: (RS) Change to color B, Knit.

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Change to color A, Knit

Row 7: Purl

Repeat rows 4 - 7, 6 more times.

Abbreviations: (WS) = Wrong Side

st = Stitch

M1 = make 1 stitch BO = Bind off

(RS) = Right Side

Thumb Shaping: Continue to change colors as established & continue to work in stockinette st.

Row 1: (RS) K19, pm, M1, K4, M1, pm, K19

Row 2: Purl

INC Row: K to 1st marker, slip marker, M1, K to 2nd marker, M1, slip marker, K to end of row.

Repeat INC Row on every RS row until there are 20 sts between the 2 markers.

NEXT Row, Row 16: (WS) Purl to 1st marker, BO 20 sts between markers, purl to end.

Row 17: K18, K the st behind the next st on the left needle then K the st that was in front to twist them, K to end.

Work 5 more rows in set color & st pattern.

Top band: Change to color A.

Row 1: (RS) Knit

Row 2: *P2, K2, repeat from *.

Row 3 & 4: Knit the knits & purls the purls.

Row 5: Bind off in rib pattern.

Using the Mattress stitch, seam up the sides for an invisible seam. Take the time to do this step right & your stripes will match up perfectly.
