What should I know about composer pages?

1. Browsing will often bring you to a composer page with works arranged alphabetically at the bottom.
2. Composer pages often have external links to detailed biographies, recordings, and other resources concerning the composer.
3. Use the Alphabet shortcut links or Intersections links to reduce the list of works to titles starting with a specific letter or to specific subcategories.
4. Use "See Also" links to explore related resources in IMSLP. Many composers have a List of Compositions that may aid you in selecting works to view.
