

## Bill Summaries

### House Votes

**Smarter Transportation (HB 1155)** – Makes sure future transportation projects are consistent with state smart growth goals and greenhouse gas emission limits.

### Oyster Poaching (HB 1191)

– Protects oyster sanctuaries by revoking the licenses of convicted poachers.

### Forest Conservation (HB 1352)

– Raises fees for development that impacts forests outside of priority growth areas.

### Solar Energy (SB 277)

– Accelerates the production of solar power used in Maryland over the next five years.

### BPA Ban (HB 33)

– Bans the toxic chemical bisphenol A from baby products.

### Oyster Poaching

– Amendment to SB 342 (see HB 1191 above) that would have delayed expansion of oyster sanctuaries.

### Solar Energy (SB 277)

– See above.

### Green Buildings (SB 234)

– Establishes green building standards for community colleges.
