### Sparkling & Champagne

#### Corney & Barrow Sparkling Blanc de Blancs

Refreshing, champagne-style fizz from renowned French sparkling wine producers.

#### Champagne Delamotte Brut

An elegant, refined and very drinkable champagne from one of the region's most prestigious houses.

### White

#### Corney & Barrow House White, Vin de Pays du Gers, France

A fresh, aromatic and zesty wine and very good with or without food.

#### Cranswick Smith Bin 410 Semillon-Chardonnay, Australia

Appealing tropical fruit flavours and soft rounded texture with just a touch of vanilla.

Beautiful citrus aromas and a delicious, crisp bite, with plenty of juicy fruit flavours and a crisp minerality.

#### Chablis Les Deux Rives Olivier Leflaive, France

Textbook Chablis with appealing orchard fruits and a tangy 'steely' finish.

### Rosé

#### Rosé Domaine de Montaubéron, France

Fresh and full of fruit flavours with hints of white blossom. Vivacious and well-balanced, with delicious acidity and length.

### Red

#### Corney & Barrow House Red, France

Versatile house wine balancing red fruit flavours, soft tannins and subtle spices.

#### Domaine de Saissac Cabernet Sauvignon, France

Sweet aromas of ripe cassis and cedar. Partially aged in oak, this wine has wonderful fruit concentration and a fine balance.

#### Víña Mar Pinot Noir, Chile

A bright nose of spicy ripe plum and cherry and elegant on the palate, with juicy, forest fruit and cinnamon spice flavours.

#### Lar de Paula Rioja, Spain

Rich and chocolate-smooth with classic baked fruit flavours, dried herbs and warm spices.

#### Château Bel Air, France

An immediately accessible claret, with concentrated fruit, supple tannins and a velvety finish.

#### Eradus Pinot Noir, New Zealand

Ripe, fresh redcurrant flavours with smoky notes and fine balance.
