### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of Congress from the twentieth Congressional District in the Counties of Columbia, Delaware, Dutchess, Essex, Greene, Otsego, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Warren, and Washington caused by the resignation of Kirsten E. Gillibrand, Member of Congress from the said District;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, David A. Paterson, Governor of the State of New York, pursuant to Section 42 of the Public Officers Law, do hereby order and proclaim that an election for Member of Congress in the place and for the unexpired term of the said Kirsten E. Gillibrand be held in the twentieth Congressional District on the thirty-first day of March, two thousand nine, such election to be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for election of New York State Members of Congress.
