

“IMPORTANT NOTICE”
FELTER V. SALAZAR PLAINTIFFS
APRIL 1, 2010

This Notice is being sent to all “Heads of the Family” who are Plaintiffs in the important *Felter v. Salazar* appeal. I urge you to inform your children who are on the case about what I am saying in this letter.

On March 11, 2010, I sent a Report on the status of the Appeal of the decision dismissing our case to all Heads of the Family's. I explained to you the procedures that would have to be taken to Appeal Judge Roberts Decision to the U.S. Court of Appeals in Washington D.C. I also informed you that I had filed the formal “Notice of Appeal” and attached a copy of that document to your letter.

On March 15th 2010, I received the Clerk’s verification of my filing of the Notice of Appeal with U. S. Court of Appeal along with an “Order” listing all the documents that would have to be filed by April 14th and April 29, 2010. There are nine (9) documents that I have to research ,draft ,complete and file before April 29, 2010 by Order of the Court.

My March 11, 2010 Report asked that each *Felter* Plaintiff send in a contribution of two hundred dollars. I asked that no partial payments be made because it is important to have the funds to carry out this case when we need those funds. April is right around the corner, and I still have had no response from you. That is the reason why this Notice is being sent to you. If I didn't feel it was absolutely necessary, I would have let the March 11, 2010 letter serve its purpose. However, the responses to my prior letter has been very disappointing.

In order for me to do my job get the necessary documents researched and filed along with a filing fee, it is necessary for each and everyone of you to send in your requested contribution before or by April 5, 2010. If no more contributions are sent in by or before that date I will notify the Court to let them know we **will not be Appealing Felter v. Salazar.** You must realize that none of us that work on this case can afford to carry the expenses of this case through the courts on our “Journey to Justice”. I want to thank the “few” good consistent supporters who sent in what they could but it is not enough to keep our case alive.

I hoped you would feel the same as I did that we have an extremely good chance of getting a well-grounded appeal before the U.S. Court of Appeals and getting a good decision handed down. From the lack of responses to my March 11 letter, I am forced to believe that this is not the situation.

There is nothing more I can say to you except I am therefore putting each of you on Notice that unless contributions are received for the Appeal and other crucial expenses before or by April 5, 2010, **the Felter case will end.** ***I will wait until that date to see the response back from you. If we hear nothing from each of you then I will notify the Court of Appeals that we are forced to voluntarily dismiss the case. I simply cannot go forward with the Appeal when the vast majority of the individual Plaintiffs do not care about helping to pay for the cost of the litigation.***

The decision is yours, as we cannot and will not continue to send theses notices out when
