## Teseo V-Neck Sweater

Using Di.Ve` Teseo Yarn from Cascade

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## Materials

Yarn - $8(8,9)$ balls Di-ve "Teseo" (98yds/ball)
Finished Size 35(37", 39")

## Needles

Size 8 US and 10 US Or size to obtain gauge

## Gauge

3.5 sts $=$ inch

## Back

With size 8 needle, cast on $67(69,71)$ stitches.
Row 1: "K1, P1. Rep from * end k1. Work 13 rows. On row 14, increase $7(8,9)$ sts evenly across row. 74(77, 80) stitches. Change to size 10 needles. Work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 10(11, 12)". Place underarm markers. Continue until piece measures 20.5(20.5, 21.5)" or until desired length.
Bind off all stitches.

## Front

Work as for back, including all shaping.
At the same time
when piece measures 10 1/2(11, 11)"
Begin Neck Shaping
Work to center stitch, place center stitch on holder, attach another ball of yarn and complete row. Work both sides at once.
Dec 1 stitch at each neck edge every 2nd row 3(1,2) times, then every 4th row $9(10,10)$ times. Continue until piece measures $20(20.5,21)$ or until desired length..

## Work sleeves

## Sleeves

With size 8 needles cast on $32(34,36)$ stitches. Work same as body rib for 14 rows. Change to size 10 needles with right side facing, increase 1 stitch on each side every 4th row for 18 times. 68(70, 72). Continue until piece measures 19(19 1/2, 21)" or until desired length. Bind off all stitches.

## Finishing

Join seams, Weave in all ends

## Neck Shaping

With size 8 needles and right side facing, pick up 24(24,24) stitches from back of neck, pick up $38(38,39)$ stitches from left neck edge, place center marker. Make 1 stitch in center, pm, pick up $38(38,39)$ stitches from right neck edge, place end of round marker. 101 $(101,103)$ stitches.
Round 1: Work in k1, p1 ribbing to within 2 stitches of center marker, ssk, pass marker, k1, pass marker, k2tog, work in k1, p1 ribbing to end of round.
Round 2: Work in estab ribbing to within 2 stitches of center marker, ssk, pass marker, k1, k2tog, work in estab ribbing to end of round.
Repeat round 2 for approx 1 1/2".
Bind off loosely.
