

## **FOX News/Opinion Dynamics Poll**

1 November 04

Polling was conducted by telephone October 30-31, 2004 during the day and in the evenings. The total sample is 1,400 registered voters (RV), with a subsample of 1,200 likely voters (LV) nationwide. For registered and likely voters there is a margin of error of  $\pm 3$  percentage points. Past results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
