Re: Comprehensive Drive Time Regulations

This Bulletin contains changes to the existing drive-time regulations as printed and previously amended by Bulletin. These Regulations are hereby amended to read:

- 1. ALMS SSR Section 1, Article 2.2.3
- Effective immediately, the Article is amended to read:

The minimum lap count required for a Driver to be eligible for points will be listed in the Supplementary Regulations.

- 2. ALMS SSR Section 1, Article 2.2.5
- Effective immediately, the Article is amended to read:

Drivers will be awarded points only in the car they drive during the race. For the LMPC and GTC classes, drivers will be awarded points in the highest finishing car that they have driven in the event.

- 3. ALMS SSR Article 21.2
- Effective immediately, the Article is amended to read:

21.2 Maximum Driving Time: SR

DRIVERS MAY NOT EXCEED THE DRIVING TIME LISTED IN THE SR.

Penalty: For LMP and GT class competitors; Exclusion of car, Drivers and Entrant.

Penalty: For Challenge class competitors; Exclusion of car, Drivers and Entrant in which drive-time was exceeded.

Note: Computation of the time requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA and is not subject to protest or appeal.

#### **EXAMPLE**:

- 21.2 Maximum Driving Time:
- a. Driver may not drive more than two (2) hours total in the race.
- b. Reserve drivers are not permitted.

c. Drivers entered in more than one Challenge class car will have their drive-time calculated cumulatively.

### 4. ALMS SSR Article 21.3

• Effective immediately, the Article is amended to read:

## 21.3 Minimum Driving Laps: SR

DRIVERS MUST ACHIEVE THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF LAPS LISTED IN THE SR.

Penalty: No points will be awarded to any driver that does not achieve the minimum lap count requirement.

Note: Computation of the lap count requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA and is not subject to protest or appeal.

#### **EXAMPLE**:

# 21.3 - Minimum Driving Laps:

- a. A Driver must drive for a minimum of twenty (20) laps total in the race.
- b. Drivers entered in more than one Challenge class car will have their laps calculated individually (a Driver must do the minimum number of laps in each car in order to be eligible for points for that car).
