EXOCET AM39 is the surface-to-air version of the EXOCET family. EXOCET AM39 can be launched from strike aircraft, Maritime Patrol Aircraft and medium um to heavy-weight helicopters throughout their speed and altitude envelopes.


With a range of 50 to 70 km, depending on the altitude and speed of the aircraft, the EXOCET AM39 enables aircraft to stay out of range of the anti-aircraft weapons of attacking surface vessels.

Ordered by the French Navy for its Super-Etendard and Atlantic aircraft ATL 2 and by many foreign countries, the EXOCET AM39 has already been installed on many different types of aircraft, including helicopters.

EXOCET AM39 will also be adapted on Rafale F3 version by 2007. EXOCET AM39 is combat proven.
