

Memorial Stadium



Description: Synthetic Turf Stadium

Located at the corner of Leland & Ludlow Streets, behind Deering High School. Seating 3200 spectators, this field has just completed a major renovation.

Annual Use – 1500 hrs

Responsibilities: City of Portland

100% maintained by the City of Portland. All goals are owned by the City and used by DHS and other field users. Standard field maintenance and stadium cleanliness is the responsibility of the Athletic Facilities group as well as the concession stand and scoreboard/PA.

Existing Site Amenities: Large (old, outdated) concession stand (originally built by boosters and maintained by us), maintenance shed, large press box, Large scoreboard and good but undersized P/A system both maintained by us.

Field Users:

Early Spring – College lacrosse, Rugby & premiere soccer

Spring- DHS, college lacrosse, premier soccer, Rugby, Adult leagues, Sea Dogs Fireworks, Ultimate Frisbee, Private High School and adult lacrosse.

Existing Field Amenities: Synthetic Turf, sewn in football & soccer lines all other lines painted, free standing Pro style football goal posts. Paved access all around the field and concession stand. Bus parking.

Recent Maintenance or Improvements: New stands in 2005, new Musco “Green” lighting system in 2006 and new turf/landscaping/drainage in 2007.

Rest and Recovery Time: Synthetic Turf does not require Rest & Recovery, only bi-weekly maintenance.

Summer – DHS, Sea Dog Fireworks, Adult Leagues, Youth Leagues, Summer Camps, Adult Football.

Fall – DHS, Middle School Football, PAYSA, PYFL, Private School sports, Adult Leagues and charity football
