



**ALL INDIA DAILY WEATHER REPORT** (Issued on 14/12/2010)

**"Evening"**

**Main Weather Observations (recorded during past 24 hours)**

- ◆ Scattered rainfall has occurred over coastal Tamil Nadu and isolated over coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema and Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Mainly dry weather conditions prevailed over rest of the country.
- ◆ The chief amounts of rainfall (in cms) recorded at 0830 hours IST of today are : Nellore-2 and Karaikal, Atiramapattinam and Pamban-1 each.
- ◆ Actual minimum temperatures are between 5-8°C over most parts of plains of northwest India and some parts of central India.
- ◆ The lowest minimum temperature of 3.2°C was recorded at Narnaul (Haryana) in the plains of the country.
- ◆ KALPANA-1 Cloud imagery at 1430 hours IST shows low/medium clouds over parts of western Himalayan region, northeastern states and peninsular India.

**Synoptic Features based on 1430 hrs IST**

- ◆ The upper air cyclonic circulation over southwest Bay of Bengal adjoining coastal Tamilnadu extending upto mid-tropospheric levels persists.
- ◆ Dry northwesterly winds are prevailing over northwest and central India.

**Major Feature of Weather Forecast (upto 0830 hours IST of 17th December, 2010)**

- ◆ Scattered rain/thundershowers would occur over extreme south peninsular India.
- ◆ Under the influence of a feeble western disturbance, light precipitation may occur over western Himalayan region from 16th onwards.
- ◆ Mainly dry weather would prevail over plains of northwest, west, central and east India.
- ◆ No significant change is expected in minimum temperatures over northwest, central and adjoining east India during next 3 days.

**Weather Warnings**

**Weather Outlook (upto 0830 hours IST of 19th December, 2010)**

- ◆ Scattered rainfall activity would occur over extreme south peninsular India and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
