



## 2011 DEFINITIVE MOZAMBIQUE PACKAGE

### GORONGOSA NATIONAL PARK – NAMPULA / ILHA DE MOZAMBIQUE - QUIRIMBAS ARCHIPELAGO

<b>DAY 1</b>	Fly from Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport to Beira Airport*	SA Airlink flies daily between Johannesburg and Beira.
	Meet & greet in Beira and road transfer into the Gorongosa National Park	A 3 hour road transfer to the Gorongosa National Park.
	Overnight at Explore Gorongosa	Stay includes: Return airport transfers; Accommodation in custom-designed mobile safari tents; All meals; All available beverages; All game activities, Mozambique VAT/IVA; Park fees.
<b>DAY 1 to 6</b>	Accommodation in the Gorongosa National Park: Accommodation option as above	The Gorongosa National Park is situated northwest of Beira near the border with Zimbabwe. It comprises 1,2 million hectares of open plain, bush, swamp and waterways, spread between the Pungwe and Urema rivers. The greater Gorongosa region is ecologically unique, situated at the southern most end of the Great African Rift Valley. As a result, it is a region with high species diversity and environmental features found nowhere else on the sub-continent.
<b>DAY 6</b>	Road transfer from the Gorongosa National Park to Beira Airport	A 3 hour road transfer direct to Beira Airport.
	Fly from Beira Airport to Nampula Airport*	Air Mozambique flies daily between Beira and Nampula.
	Meet & greet in Nampula and road transfer to the Nampula coast line	A 3 hour road transfer from Nampula Airport to the lodge.
	Overnight at Nuarro Eco Luxury Lodge	Stay includes: Transfers; Accommodation in a beach chalets; All meals, teas, coffees and snacks; Half hour back and neck massage; Dhow cruises and kayaking; Eco trails and bike rides; EVAC Medical Insurance.
<b>DAY 7 to 10</b>	Full day trip to Ilha de Mozambique	Arab, Indian and Portuguese architectural influences are blended in the port of Mozambique. Once a trading post on the sea route from Europe to the East Indies, this island harbour was placed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 1991.
	Accommodation in Nampula: Accommodation option as above	The Nanatha Bay in Nampula ends at a wonderful point known as Nuarro, formed from ancient coral rock which has eroded over aeons of time. The lodge was built by local people from local materials, so it was decided to give the lodge a local name - Nuarro.

<b>DAY 10</b>	Air hop from Nuarro's airstrip to Pemba with CF	Transfer operates on a Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.
	Meet & Greet in Pemba and air transfer from Pemba Airport to Matemo Island	A 30 minute air hop over the southern islands of the Quirimbas Archipelago and National Park with its mangrove fringed coastline takes you to Matemo Island.
	Accommodation on Matemo Island	Stay Includes: Return air transfers; Accommodation in a sea facing chalet; All meals; All local drinks; Non motorised watersports; Medical evacuation.
<b>DAY 10 to 13</b>	Accommodation at Matemo Island: Accommodation option as above	Just eight kilometres long and three kilometres wide, Matemo Island is a magical destination, with pristine beaches enveloped by an azure sea, offset by the distinctive silhouette of thousands of palm trees. Here in this Mozambique tropical paradise, some of the world's most spectacular dive sites await discovery whilst an abundance of marine life can be seen in the protected waters of the Quirimbas Archipelago National Park.
<b>DAY 13</b>	Air transfer from Matemo to Pemba Airport	A 30 minute air hop back to Pemba
	Fly from Pemba Airport to Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport*	Air Mozambique flies from Pemba to Johannesburg three times a week on a Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. SA Airlink flies from Pemba to Johannesburg on a Wednesday & Saturday.
