### **GRADING SYSTEM**

The marking system is based on a 4.0 scale. Plus or minus marks are not computed. Advanced Placement courses as well as Pre-Calculus receive one extra grade point if the grade earned is a C or above. A ninth grade through twelfth grade class rank and a tenth grade through twelfth grade class rank are calculated. Rankings are based on a weighted GPA. LAHS offers Thirteen Advanced Placement courses and six Honors courses.

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### **LOS AMIGOS HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2010 – 2011**

Los Amigos High School is one of seven comprehensive high schools in the Garden Grove Unified School District. An urban school district with a total enrollment of 47,860 students, GGUSD is the 11<sup>th</sup> largest school district in California and the 96<sup>th</sup> largest school district in the nation.

Los Amigos High School serves students from the cities of Fountain Valley and Santa Ana. The total enrollment for Los Amigos is 2,253 students. A culturally diverse community, LAHS has a student population that is 76.4% Hispanic, 17.5% Asian, 3.7% Caucasian, .6% African American, .4% Pacific Islander, and .9% Filipino and .1% Indian/Alaskan. In 2010, Los Amigos had an API of 718, a Similar School Ranking of 8 and State Ranking of 5.

### **CLASS OF 2010**

Of the 442 graduates in the class of 2010, forty-seven percent successfully completed the coursework required for Four Year College Admissions. Twenty-five percent of the class of 2010 chose to attend a four-year college, while fifty-three percent chose to attend a two-year college or vocational program. (Graduates of the Class of 2010 are attending prestigious universities that include UC Berkeley, UCI, UCSD and UCLA).
