





# Dear friends:



## OFFICIAL TRAINING

Free official training in groups on slalom course in Guizhou – Xiasi for all participating teams will be organized from 25th April till 30th April 2010.

After the Asian Championship athletes who want to stay for training 50 US dollars per person per day shall be charged.

#### ACCOMMODATION AND LOCAL TRANSPORT

The Organizing Committee will provide the accommodation (three star hotel) and local transport at the cost of 60 US dollars per person per day. Free shuttle bus will be run between the hotel and the venue.

#### **EQUIPMENT RENT**

The Organizing Committee has prepared a limited number of boats for rent. 300 US dollars will be charged for 10 days (if over 10 days, it will cost 30 US dollars per day). First come first served. Please send your intention of renting boats together with the Numerical Entry Form.

## Timing and Video

Electronic timing will be used for the race, and the video signal of the race will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

#### FLIGHTS AND TRANSPORTATION OF BOATS

There are connecting flights from Beijing, Guangzhou or Shanghai to Guiyang city everyday. Please inform us of your flight information (flight number, arriving and departure time, number of persons and boats in advance) for our arrangement of the transportation and pick-up at Guiyang airport.

The Organizing Committee will help to transport the boats for the teams free who have participated in the "Dynamic Guangzhou" Open from Guangzhou to Guiyang.

#### VISA

Visa is needed for every participant. It will take us at least one month to
