DONAU went into the lead soon after the start, was then restrained in front for a mile and, when called on, drew away, but was tiring at the end and barely lasted long enough. JOE MORRIS tried to run out on the first turn, and moved up with a rush on the stretch turn and seemed the winner, but tired only to come again gamely near the end. FIGHTING BOB made a resolute effort after going a half and stood the final drive gamely. BOOLA BOOLA saved ground when turning into the stretch, closed a big gap and was going fastest at the end and would probably have won at a longer distance. The others were never serious contenders.
