### ANSWERS

Here is what Tracy Beaker did, below are the answers:

1. b

In Episode 1, 'The Burneywood Menace.'

Mike reveals to Tracy that the Dumping Ground will be shut down by the council, as it's too expensive to run. Out of desperation, she decides to tip off the local TV and newspaper journalists, climbs to the roof top and starts campaigning. However, her dangerous action leads another character to have a disastrous fall!

In Episode 3, 'Crushed.'

When Lily moves into Cam's house, Tracy starts to feel jealous as she is used to having Cam to herself. She thinks that her evening job at the local pizza shop will keep her mind off things. But will she manage to fight the green eyed monster and accept Lily?

In Episode 4, 'Refugees.'

Tracy tries to cheer Lily up by having a lunch party, inviting Carmen and Tee. The girls want to have fun by holding a fashion show. However, all the fun ends when Mike rings Tracy to say the two refugees staying at the Dumping Ground have gone missing!

In Episode 5, 'Money.'

When a big bag of money is dumped in the garden, Liam, Frank and Toby decide to hide it in their bedrooms. Carmen and the others find it and stash the cash in their rooms. Tracy eventually finds out, tells the kids they have no choice but to tell the cops and takes the sack to Mike and Gina. Honesty is always the best policy but are the cops telling the truth?

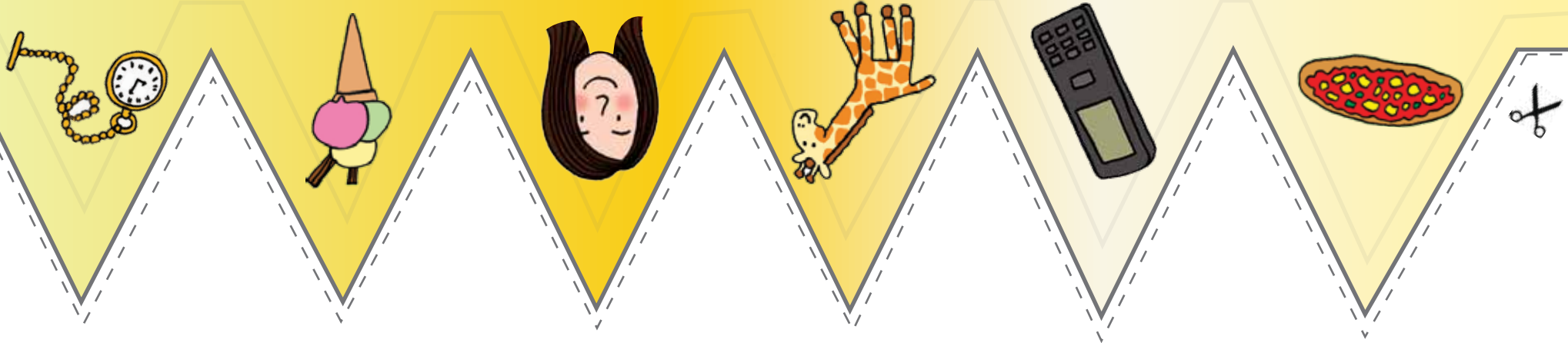
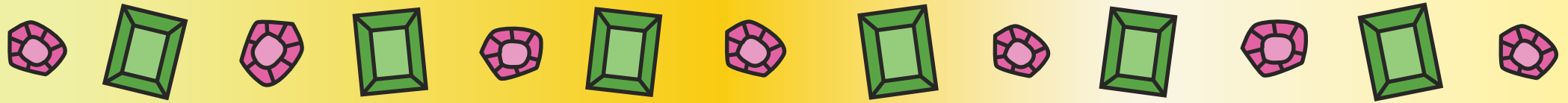

# THE BEAKER CROWN

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out both crown shapes ( be careful when cutting, ask an adult to help )
2. Glue both shapes together to create one long crown.
3. Wrap round head, until you find it fits. Mark the spot then glue it together!
