



his year marks the 19th for **AIN**'s survey of American FBOs. From the start, it has been intended to be an evaluation of the FBOs with which aviation professionals do business, and the survey is compiled from ratings made by those professionals. **AIN** has no input into the ratings. Although the evaluations of individual FBOs give the appearance of a contest, there is no voting for a favorite FBO, only numerical evaluations by those familiar with the service providers and facilities. The categories in the survey were carefully chosen and adjusted over the years to reflect the evolving variety of services and facilities offered at FBOs.

This year has seen one major change in the administration of the survey. For the first time, respondents were invited to perform their evaluations online at a dedicated, secure Web site, rather than filling out a paper survey form and mailing it back. AIN partnered with research firm Forecast International of Newtown, Conn., to establish the Web site and collect the data.

A total of 12,582 qualified **AIN** subscribers were selected to participate in the survey. They were notified either by e-mail, fax or letter (including a conventional paper questionnaire form for those without Internet access) and instructed how to file their evaluation on the secure Web site administered by Forecast International. The response was gratifying, as legions of cyber-savvy pilots, flight department managers and dispatchers embraced the new Internet-based survey format.

This year's response rate was dramatic, as 1,985 participants completed the questionnaire (only 161 of whom stuck with the old-style printed version sent via snail mail). That represents a response rate of 15.8 percent, up from 10.3 percent last year when only written responses were received.

Also new for this year, the survey is reporting FBOs' evaluations in all four categories numerically rather than using the colored-dot format from years past. Hard numbers, including the facility's overall average rating covering all four categories, should provide more distinct information for readers.

We at **AIN** prefer not to think of the survey as a contest, but the list of the top-ranked operations always draws enthusiastic readership among FBO management.

This year, we have chosen to list the 40 facilities that received an overall average rating of 8.0 or higher out of a possible 10. Wilson Air Center of Memphis, Tenn. (average rating 9.052), continues its dominance with top-scoring honors for the sixth consecutive survey edition. With its service philosophy based on owner Kemmons Wilson's legacy as founder of the Holiday Inn hotel chain, Wilson topped second-place finisher Regal Aviation of Dallas by 0.291 of a point (average rating 8.761). The latter moved up nine positions from its last-year's placement.

Finishing number three, AirFlite/Avitat at Daugherty Field in Long Beach, Calif. (average rating 8.652), has been a perennial high scorer in the AIN survey. In the fourth position this year, newcomer Tampa International Jet Center (average rating 8.628), in its second year of operation, is led by industry veteran Phil Botana. Rounding out the top five, Business Jet Center (average rating 8.589), the popular Love Field (Dallas) facility, moved up one notch this year, led by chairman and managing general partner Robert Wright.

Pilots can have strong feelings about the FBOs they patronize. They are proud professionals in the service business themselves. As aviators, they are trained to have the highest standards of safety and performance. Those standards tend to govern their service mentality as well. The relationship between a business pilot and an FBO is critical. The pilot depends on the FBO to meet or exceed the service standards each passenger encounters inside the cabin.

When pilots feel they, or their passengers, have been treated poorly, they are not shy about passing on the bad news. Conversely, when they find good service, they are equally quick to pass on the information. The purpose of **AIN**'s annual FBO survey is to provide a formal, scientific vehicle for that exchange of information.—*Mark Phelps, Senior Editor*



Il evaluations for the 2006 **Aviation International News** survey of American FBOs were made by business aviation professionals who actually used these facilities. The evaluations were made purely for the benefit of fellow pilots. **AIN** provided no opinions of its own, nor did it in any way attempt to influence the opinions of the survey participants.

This year's American survey-AIN's 19th since 1981-asked participants to evaluate FBOs they visited in 2005. (AIN has also surveyed European FBOs five times.) A total of 12,582 flight department managers, dispatchers and other company executives were selected from AIN's subscription list. All were contacted either by e-mail, fax or letter and asked to go to a secure Web site to complete the survey form. Paper forms were also mailed for those who chose to use them. A total of 161 respondents returned paper forms.

it must receive a minimum of 40 evaluations; the minimum for FBOs located in Canada or Latin America is 25 evaluations.

One noteworthy turn of events in this year's survey involves write-in evaluations. The most any facility received last year was five-not even close to the number needed for inclusion in the final report.

This year, 17 write-in facilities received the requisite number of evaluations–40 for U.S. operations (of which there were 10) and 25 evaluations for non-U.S. facilities (of which there were seven that made the final cut). That illustrates the flexibility of the new Web-based format. The results can only be seen as more accurate representations of where business aviation is flying.

Respondents were asked to rate each FBO based on the following criteria: line service; passenger amenities; pilot amenities and services; and

facilities. Survey respondents judged each category on a scale of one to 10, with 10 indicating the highest rating. (Previously, the category rat-

ing scale was from zero to nine, so readers should consider this when comparing ratings from earlier surveys with this year's survey.) The average number of FBOs rated by each participant this year was 14.9, down from last year's 23.3.

Each FBO's ratings for each of the four categories were added, with the resulting sum divided by the number of responses received for the particular FBO to arrive at an average for that category. An overall average was computed by adding the FBO's scores for each category and dividing that sum by the total number of responses received in all four categories. The result is the FBO's overall average score.

For the second year in a row respondents were not shy about slamming facilities they saw as lacking. Two facilities, ranging from the U.S. East to West Coasts, elicited average ratings of lower than four out of 10. If your travel plans include a trip between New York JFK Airport's general aviation terminal (average rating 3.927) and Livermore (Calif.) Municipal Airport (average rating 3.732), you should adjust your expectations accordingly.—M.P.

survey rules and methodology

This is the only FBO survey consistently conducted under the same controlled, scientific format year after year. Results are based on empirical data collected from a random sample of business aviation professionals. A total of 1,985 respondents completed acceptable survey forms, for a 15.8-percent return–a major leap from the 10.3-percent return last year when only paper forms were involved.

The response to the new format shows that aviation professionals have embraced the Web, and the results are indicative of the importance **AIN** readers place on the information contained in this report. As further evidence of the reach of the aptly named World Wide Web, for the third time this year's survey included **AIN** readers based in Central and South America.

The list that appears here includes 245 FBOs represented on the survey form. Facilities that failed to meet the required cutoff number of evaluations do not appear on the final report. To ensure the statistical validity of the results, **AIN** required that for a U.S. FBO to be included in the final report
