- 6) What is the name for a large enclosure used for housing birds?
- 7) What is the name of the official dance of Brazil?
- 8) What is the name of the most famous and sought after piece of meat found in traditional Brazilian churrascarias (steak houses)? (hint: the waiter yells the name when he comes to the table)
- 9) How many species of flightless birds are there?
- 10) What famous sport do Brazilians love best? (Hint: they are watching it on TV during one scene in the movie)
- 11) What very famous traditional Brazilian song is sung briefly in the movie? (Hint: Rafael sings a bar or two to his wife)
- 12) What famous statue that was named one of the New Seven Wonders of the World is shown in the movie?

Scavenger Hunt Answers

- 1) **Brazil**, the 5th biggest country in the world and the largest in South America! **Capital**: Brasília
- 2) **South America**
- 3) **Ornithology**, so Tulio is an ornithologist
- 4) **Carnaval** (Carnival in English), celebrated annually 40 days prior to Easter
- 5) **Tudo bem or tudo bom** (Everything good?), you can also respond to the question with the same phrase
- 6) **Aviary**
- 7) **Samba**, a dance which has Brazilian and African roots. It is almost synonymous with Brazil and Carnaval.
- 8) **Picanha** (rump cover), generally cooked on a spit, it is served in Brazilian style churrascaria barbecue. Most major US cities now have a Brazilian restaurant or two. If you like meat, you have to try it. You will never taste anything better!
- 9) **About 40**
- 10) **Soccer** (or, in Brazil, futebol)
- 11) **"The Girl from Ipanema"** (Ipanema is a seaside area of Rio)
- 12) **Cristo Redentor** (Christ the Redeemer), the 2nd largest art deco statue in the world
