The amount of VLF is then distributed: $0.65 \%$ is split between the Local Revenue Fund and the Motor Vehicle License Fee Account, $0.35 \%$ to the General Fund, and $0.15 \%$ to the Local Safety and Protection Account. The average VLF is calculated based on June - August 2010 data.
    ** The first $\$ 122$ of the CVRA fee is allocated to the Motor Vehicle Account.
