## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2011, and for other purposes.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 That the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Public 4 Law 111–242) is further amended— 5 (1) by striking the date specified in section 106(3) and inserting "April 8, 2011"; and 6 7 (2) by adding after section 226, as added by the Further Continuing Appropriations Amend-8 9 ments, 2011 (Public Law 112–4), the following new

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sections:

"SEC. 227. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
 are provided for 'Agricultural Programs—Agricultural Re search Service—Salaries and Expenses' at a rate for oper ations of \$1,135,501,000.

5 "SEC. 228. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
6 are provided for 'Agricultural Programs—Agricultural Re7 search Service—Buildings and Facilities' at a rate for op8 erations of \$0.

9 "SEC. 229. 10 Ireland' at a rate for operations of \$0.
