JOINT RESOLUTION

Making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year
2011, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Public
4 Law 111–242) is further amended—

5 (1) by striking the date specified in section
6 106(3) and inserting “April 8, 2011”; and

7 (2) by adding after section 226, as added by
8 the Further Continuing Appropriations Amend-
9 ments, 2011 (Public Law 112–4), the following new
10 sections:

1 “SEC. 227. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
2 are provided for ‘Agricultural Programs—Agricultural Re-
3 search Service—Salaries and Expenses’ at a rate for oper-
4 ations of \$1,135,501,000.

5 “SEC. 228. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
6 are provided for ‘Agricultural Programs—Agricultural Re-
7 search Service—Buildings and Facilities’ at a rate for op-
8 erations of \$0.

9 “SEC. 229. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
10 are provided for ‘Agricultural Programs—National Insti-
11 tute of Food and Agriculture—Research and Education
12 Activities’ at a rate for operations of \$665,345,000: *Pro-*
13 *vided*, That the amounts included under such heading in
14 Public Law 111–80 shall be applied to funds appropriated
15 by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$89,029,000’ and
16 ‘\$11,253,000’ for ‘\$45,122,000’.

17 “SEC. 230. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
18 are provided for ‘Agricultural Programs—National Insti-
19 tute of Food and Agriculture—Extension Activities’ at a
20 rate for operations of \$483,092,000: *Provided*, That the
21 amounts included under such heading in Public Law 111–
22 80 shall be applied to funds appropriated by this Act by
23 substituting ‘\$8,565,000’ for ‘\$20,396,000’.

24 “SEC. 231. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
25 are provided for ‘Agricultural Programs—Animal and

1 Plant Health Inspection Service—Salaries and Expenses’
2 at a rate for operations of \$880,543,000.

3 “SEC. 232. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
4 are provided for ‘Conservation Programs—Natural Re-
5 sources Conservation Service—Conservation Operations’
6 at a rate for operations of \$850,247,000.

7 “SEC. 233. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
8 are provided for ‘Conservation Programs—Natural Re-
9 sources Conservation Service—Watershed and Flood Pre-
10 vention Operations’ at a rate for operations of \$0: *Pro-*
11 *vided*, That the amounts included under such heading in
12 Public Law 111–80 shall be applied to funds appropriated
13 by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$12,000,000’.

14 “SEC. 234. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
15 are provided for ‘Rural Development Programs—Rural
16 Housing Service—Rural Housing Insurance Fund Pro-
17 gram Account’ for the cost of direct and guaranteed loans,
18 including the cost of modifying loans, at a rate for oper-
19 ations of \$70,200,000: *Provided*, That the amounts in-
20 cluded under such heading in Public Law 111–80 shall
21 be applied to funds appropriated by this Act by sub-
22 stituting ‘\$70,200,000’ for ‘\$40,710,000’ in the case of
23 direct loans and ‘\$0’ for ‘\$172,800,000’ in the case of un-
24 subsidized guaranteed loans.

1 “SEC. 235. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
2 are provided for ‘Rural Development Programs—Rural
3 Business-Cooperative Service—Rural Cooperative Devel-
4 opment Grants’ at a rate for operations of \$31,754,000:
5 *Provided*, That the amounts included under such heading
6 in Public Law 111–80 shall be applied to funds appro-
7 priated by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$300,000’ and
8 ‘\$0’ for ‘\$2,800,000’.

9 “SEC. 236. Sections 718, 723, 727, 728, and 738 of
10 Public Law 111–80 shall be applied to funds appropriated
11 by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for each of the dollar
12 amounts specified in those sections.

13 “SEC. 237. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
14 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—International
15 Trade Administration—Operations and Administration’ at
16 a rate for operations of \$450,989,000: *Provided*, That the
17 sixth proviso under such heading in division B of Public
18 Law 111–117 shall not apply to funds appropriated by
19 this Act.

20 “SEC. 238. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
21 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—Minority
22 Business Development Agency—Minority Business Devel-
23 opment’ at a rate for operations of \$30,400,000: *Provided*,
24 That the first proviso under such heading in division B

1 of Public Law 111–117 shall not apply to funds appro-
2 priated by this Act.

3 “SEC. 239. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
4 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—National In-
5 stitute of Standards and Technology—Scientific and
6 Technical Research and Services’ at a rate for operations
7 of \$504,500,000: *Provided*, That the second proviso under
8 such heading in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall
9 not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

10 “SEC. 240. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
11 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—National In-
12 stitute of Standards and Technology—Construction of Re-
13 search Facilities’ at a rate for operations of \$100,000,000:
14 *Provided*, That the first proviso under such heading in di-
15 vision B of Public Law 111–117 shall not apply to funds
16 appropriated by this Act.

17 “SEC. 241. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
18 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—National
19 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration—Operations,
20 Research, and Facilities’ at a rate for operations of
21 \$3,205,883,000: *Provided*, That the sixth proviso under
22 such heading in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall
23 not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

24 “SEC. 242. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
25 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—National

1 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration—Procurement,
2 Acquisition and Construction’ at a rate for operations of
3 \$1,340,353,000: *Provided*, That the sixth proviso under
4 such heading in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall
5 not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

6 “SEC. 243. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
7 are provided for ‘Department of Justice—Office of Justice
8 Programs—State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance’
9 at a rate for operations of \$1,349,500,000: *Provided*, That
10 the amount included in paragraph (4) under such heading
11 in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall be applied to
12 funds appropriated by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for
13 ‘\$185,268,000’.

14 “SEC. 244. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
15 are provided for ‘Department of Justice—Office of Justice
16 Programs—Juvenile Justice Programs’ at a rate for oper-
17 ations of \$332,500,000: *Provided*, That the amount in-
18 cluded in paragraph (2) under such heading in division
19 B of Public Law 111–117 shall be applied to funds appro-
20 priated by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$91,095,000’.

21 “SEC. 245. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
22 are provided for ‘Department of Justice—Community Ori-
23 ented Policing Services’ at a rate for operations of
24 \$597,500,000: *Provided*, That the amounts included under
25 such heading in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall

1 be applied to funds appropriated by this Act as follows:
2 in paragraph (2), by substituting ‘\$15,000,000’ for
3 ‘\$40,385,000’ and by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$25,385,000’;
4 and in paragraph (3), by substituting ‘\$1,500,000’ for
5 ‘\$170,223,000’ and by substituting ‘\$0’ for
6 ‘\$168,723,000’.

7 “SEC. 246. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
8 are provided for ‘National Aeronautics and Space Admin-
9 istration—Cross Agency Support’ at a rate for operations
10 of \$3,131,000,000: *Provided*, That the third proviso under
11 such heading in division B of Public Law 111–117 shall
12 not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

13 “SEC. 247. Of the funds made available for ‘Depart-
14 ment of Commerce—Bureau of the Census—Periodic
15 Censuses and Programs’ in division B of Public Law 111–
16 117, \$1,740,000,000 is rescinded.

17 “SEC. 248. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
18 are provided for ‘Department of Commerce—National
19 Telecommunications and Information Administration—
20 Public Telecommunications Facilities, Planning and Con-
21 struction’ at a rate for operations of \$0.

22 “SEC. 249. Of the unobligated balances available for
23 ‘Emergency Steel, Oil, and Gas Guaranteed Loan Pro-
24 gram Account’, \$48,000,000 is rescinded.

1 “SEC. 250. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
2 are provided for ‘Department of the Treasury—Commu-
3 nity Development Financial Institutions Fund Program
4 Account’ at a rate for operations of \$243,600,000, and
5 the funding designation of \$3,150,000 for an additional
6 pilot project grant under such heading in division C of
7 Public Law 111–117 shall not apply to funds appropriated
8 by this Act.

9 “SEC. 251. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
10 are provided for ‘Executive Office of the President and
11 Funds Appropriated to the President—Office of National
12 Drug Control Policy—Other Federal Drug Control Pro-
13 grams’ at a rate for operations of \$152,150,000, and the
14 matter under such heading in division C of Public Law
15 111–117 relating to the National Drug Court Institute
16 and the National Alliance for Model State Drug Laws
17 shall not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

18 “SEC. 252. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
19 are provided for ‘District of Columbia—Federal Funds—
20 Federal Payment to the Office of the Chief Financial Offi-
21 cer for the District of Columbia’ at a rate for operations
22 of \$0.

23 “SEC. 253. Notwithstanding section 101, the aggre-
24 gate amount of new obligational authority provided under
25 the heading ‘General Services Administration—Real Prop-

1 erty Activities—Federal Buildings Fund—Limitations on
2 Availability of Revenue’ for Federal buildings and court-
3 houses and other purposes of the Fund shall be available
4 at a rate for operations of \$7,519,772,000, of which: (1)
5 \$0 is for ‘Construction and Acquisition’; and (2)
6 \$284,000,000 is for ‘Repairs and Alterations’ for Special
7 Emphasis Programs and Basic Repairs and Alterations.

8 “SEC. 254. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
9 are provided for ‘General Services Administration—Gen-
10 eral Activities—Operating Expenses’ at a rate for oper-
11 ations of \$71,881,000, and the matter relating to the
12 amount of \$1,000,000 under such heading in division C
13 of Public Law 111–117 shall not apply to funds appro-
14 priated by this Act.

15 “SEC. 255. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
16 are provided for ‘National Archives and Records Adminis-
17 tration—Repairs and Restoration’ at a rate for operations
18 of \$11,848,000.

19 “SEC. 256. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
20 are provided for section 523 of division C of Public Law
21 111–117 at a rate for operations of \$0.

22 “SEC. 257. Of the unobligated balances available for
23 ‘Department of Homeland Security—U.S. Customs and
24 Border Protection—Construction and Facilities Manage-
25 ment’ for construction projects, \$106,556,000 is re-

1 rescinded: *Provided*, That the amounts rescinded under this
2 section shall be limited to amounts available for Border
3 Patrol projects and facilities: *Provided further*, That no
4 amounts in this section may be rescinded from amounts
5 that were designated by Congress as an emergency re-
6 quirement pursuant to a concurrent resolution on the
7 budget or the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit
8 Control Act of 1985.

9 “SEC. 258. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
10 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—Bureau of
11 Land Management—Management of Lands and Re-
12 sources’ at a rate for operations of \$957,971,000: *Pro-*
13 *vided*, That the amounts included under such heading in
14 division A of Public Law 111–88 shall be applied to funds
15 appropriated by this Act by substituting “\$957,951,000”
16 for “\$959,571,000” the second place it appears.

17 “SEC. 259. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
18 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—Bureau of
19 Land Management—Construction’ at a rate for operations
20 of \$6,626,000.

21 “SEC. 260. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
22 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—Bureau of
23 Land Management—Land Acquisition’ at a rate for oper-
24 ations of \$26,650,000: *Provided*, That the proviso under

1 such heading in division A of Public Law 111–88 shall
2 not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

3 “SEC. 261. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
4 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—United
5 States Fish and Wildlife Service—Resource Management’
6 at a rate for operations of \$1,257,356,000.

7 “SEC. 262. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
8 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—United
9 States Fish and Wildlife Service—Construction’ at a rate
10 for operations of \$27,139,000.

11 “SEC. 263. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
12 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—United
13 States Fish and Wildlife Service—Land Acquisition’ at a
14 rate for operations of \$63,890,000.

15 “SEC. 264. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
16 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—National
17 Park Service—National Recreation and Preservation’ at
18 a rate for operations of \$57,986,000, of which \$0 shall
19 be for projects authorized by section 7302 of Public Law
20 111–11.

21 “SEC. 265. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
22 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—National
23 Park Service—Historic Preservation Fund’ at a rate for
24 operations of \$54,500,000: *Provided*, That the amounts
25 included under such heading in division A of Public Law

1 111–88 shall be applied to funds appropriated by this Act
2 by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$25,000,000’: *Provided further*,
3 That the proviso under such heading in division A of Pub-
4 lic Law 111–88 shall not apply to funds appropriated by
5 this Act.

6 “SEC. 266. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
7 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—National
8 Park Service—Construction’ at a rate for operations of
9 \$185,066,000: *Provided*, That the last proviso under such
10 heading in division A of Public Law 111–88 shall not
11 apply to funds appropriated by this Act: *Provided further*,
12 That of the unobligated balances available under such
13 heading in division A of Public Law 111–88 and prior ap-
14 propriation Acts, \$25,000,000 is rescinded, including
15 \$1,000,000 from amounts made available for the (now
16 completed) project at Cape Hatteras National Seashore,
17 North Carolina, and \$1,000,000 from amounts made
18 available for the (now completed) project at Blue Ridge
19 Parkway, North Carolina.

20 “SEC. 267. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
21 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—National
22 Park Service—Land Acquisition and State Assistance’ at
23 a rate for operations of \$108,846,000.

24 “SEC. 268. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
25 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—United

1 States Geological Survey—Surveys, Investigations, and
2 Research’ at a rate for operations of \$1,094,344,000.

3 “SEC. 269. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
4 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—Bureau of
5 Indian Affairs—Operation of Indian Programs’ at a rate
6 for operations of \$2,334,515,000.

7 “SEC. 270. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
8 are provided for ‘Department of the Interior—Depart-
9 mental Offices—Insular Affairs—Assistance to Terri-
10 tories’ at a rate for operations of \$84,295,000.

11 “SEC. 271. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
12 are provided for ‘Environmental Protection Agency—
13 Science and Technology’ at a rate for operations of
14 \$840,349,000, of which \$0 shall be for the purposes speci-
15 fied in ‘Research/National Priorities’ under the heading
16 ‘Science and Technology’ in the joint explanatory state-
17 ment of the managers accompanying Public Law 111–88.

18 “SEC. 272. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
19 are provided for ‘Environmental Protection Agency—En-
20 vironmental Programs and Management’ at a rate for op-
21 erations of \$2,963,263,000: *Provided*, That of the
22 amounts provided by this Act for such account, amounts
23 are provided for the Geographic Programs specified in the
24 joint explanatory statement of the managers accom-
25 panying Public Law 111–88 at a rate for operations of

1 \$599,875,000: *Provided further*, That of the amounts pro-
2 vided by this Act for such account, \$0 shall be for cap
3 and trade technical assistance and \$0 shall be for the pro-
4 gram specified in ‘Environmental Protection/National Pri-
5 orities’ under the heading ‘Environmental Programs and
6 Management’ in the joint explanatory statement of the
7 managers accompanying Public Law 111–88.

8 “SEC. 273. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
9 are provided for ‘Environmental Protection Agency—
10 Buildings and Facilities’ at a rate for operations of
11 \$36,501,000: *Provided*, That the amounts included under
12 such heading in division A of Public Law 111–88 shall
13 be applied to funds appropriated by this Act by sub-
14 stituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$500,000’.

15 “SEC. 274. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
16 are provided for ‘Environmental Protection Agency—
17 State and Tribal Assistance Grants’ at a rate for oper-
18 ations of \$4,777,946,000: *Provided*, That the amounts in-
19 cluded under such heading in division A of Public Law
20 111–88 shall be applied to funds appropriated by this Act
21 as follows: by substituting ‘\$14,500,000’ for
22 ‘\$17,000,000’; by substituting ‘\$10,000,000’ for
23 ‘\$13,000,000’; by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$156,777,000’; by
24 substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$20,000,000’; and by substituting
25 ‘\$1,106,446,000’ for ‘\$1,116,446,000’.

1 “SEC. 275. The matter pertaining to competitive
2 grants to communities to develop plans and demonstrate
3 and implement projects which reduce greenhouse gas
4 emissions under the heading ‘Environmental Protection
5 Agency—State and Tribal Assistance Grants’ in division
6 A of Public Law 111–88 shall not apply to funds appro-
7 priated by this Act.

8 “SEC. 276. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
9 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest
10 Service—Forest and Rangeland Research’ at a rate for
11 operations of \$311,612,000.

12 “SEC. 277. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
13 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest
14 Service—State and Private Forestry’ at a rate for oper-
15 ations of \$301,611,000.

16 “SEC. 278. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
17 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest
18 Service—National Forest System’ at a rate for operations
19 of \$1,550,089,000.

20 “SEC. 279. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
21 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest
22 Service—Capital Improvement and Maintenance’ at a rate
23 for operations of \$548,962,000.

24 “SEC. 280. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
25 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest

1 Service—Land Acquisition’ at a rate for operations of
2 \$33,184,000.

3 “SEC. 281. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
4 are provided for ‘Department of Agriculture—Forest
5 Service—Wildland Fire Management’ at a rate for oper-
6 ations of \$2,097,387,000: *Provided*, That of the unobli-
7 gated balances available under such heading in division A
8 of Public Law 111–88 and prior appropriation Acts,
9 \$200,000,000 is rescinded.

10 “SEC. 282. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
11 are provided for section 415 of division A of Public Law
12 111–88 at a rate for operations of \$0.

13 “SEC. 283. Notwithstanding section 101 and section
14 200, amounts are provided for ‘Department of Labor—
15 Employment and Training Administration—Training and
16 Employment Services’ at a rate for operations of
17 \$3,654,641,000: *Provided*, That the amounts included in
18 paragraph (3)(E) under such heading in division D of
19 Public Law 111–117 shall be applied to funds appro-
20 priated by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$125,000,000’
21 and by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$65,000,000’.

22 “SEC. 284. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
23 are provided for ‘Department of Labor—Employment and
24 Training Administration—Community Service Employ-
25 ment for Older Americans’ at a rate for operations of

1 \$600,425,000: *Provided*, That for purposes of funds ap-
2 propriated by this Act, the amounts included under such
3 heading in division D of Public Law 111–117 shall be ap-
4 plied by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$225,000,000’ in the first
5 place it appears, and the first and second provisos under
6 such heading in such division shall not apply.

7 “SEC. 285. Notwithstanding sections 101 and 203,
8 amounts are provided for ‘Department of Health and
9 Human Services—Health Resources and Services Admin-
10 istration—Health Resources and Services’ at a rate for
11 operations of \$7,001,520,000: *Provided*, That the eight-
12 eenth, nineteenth, twenty-second, and twenty-fifth pro-
13 visos under such heading in division D of Public Law 111–
14 117 shall not apply to funds appropriated by this Act.

15 “SEC. 286. Notwithstanding section 101, in addition
16 to amounts otherwise made available by section 130,
17 amounts are provided for ‘Department of Health and
18 Human Services—Office of the Secretary—Public Health
19 and Social Services Emergency Fund’ at a rate for oper-
20 ations of \$731,109,000, of which \$65,578,000 shall be for
21 expenses necessary to prepare for and respond to an influ-
22 enza pandemic (none of which shall be available past Sep-
23 tember 30, 2011) and \$35,000,000 shall be for expenses
24 necessary for fit-out and other costs related to a competi-
25 tive lease procurement to renovate or replace the existing

1 headquarters building for Public Health Service agencies
2 and other components of the Department of Health and
3 Human Services.

4 “SEC. 287. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
5 are provided for ‘Corporation for Public Broadcasting’ at
6 a rate for operations of \$36,000,000: *Provided*, That the
7 amounts included under such heading in division D of
8 Public Law 111–117 shall be applied to funds appro-
9 priated by this Act by substituting ‘\$0’ for ‘\$25,000,000’
10 each place it appears.

11 “SEC. 288. Of the funds appropriated for ‘Social Se-
12 curity Administration—Limitation on Administrative Ex-
13 penses’ for fiscal years 2010 and prior years (other than
14 funds appropriated in Public Law 111–5) for investment
15 in information technology and telecommunications hard-
16 ware and software infrastructure, \$200,000,000 is re-
17 scinded.

18 “SEC. 289. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
19 are provided for ‘House of Representatives—Salaries and
20 Expenses’ at a rate for operations of \$1,367,525,000.

21 “SEC. 290. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
22 are provided for ‘House of Representatives—Salaries, Of-
23 ficers and Employees’ at a rate for operations of
24 \$196,801,000, of which \$129,282,000 shall be for the op-
25 erations of the Office of the Chief Administrative Officer.

1 “SEC. 291. Notwithstanding section 101 and section
2 221, amounts are provided for ‘Library of Congress—Sal-
3 aries and Expenses’ at a rate for operations of
4 \$445,201,000, of which \$0 shall be for the operations de-
5 scribed in the fifth and seventh provisos under such head-
6 ing in Public Law 111–68.

7 “SEC. 292. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
8 are provided for ‘Bilateral Economic Assistance—Funds
9 Appropriated to the President—International Fund for
10 Ireland’ at a rate for operations of \$0.

11 “SEC. 293. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
12 are provided for ‘Department of Housing and Urban De-
13 velopment—Community Planning and Development—
14 Brownfields Redevelopment’ at a rate for operations of \$0.

15 “SEC. 294. Notwithstanding section 101, amounts
16 are provided for ‘Department of Transportation—Federal
17 Railroad Administration—Railroad Safety Technology
18 Program’ at a rate for operations of \$0.”.

19 This joint resolution may be cited as the “Additional
20 Continuing Appropriations Amendments, 2011”.
