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Anonymity the Story in Senate Race

Raleigh, N.C. – Ohio voters aren't particularly familiar with any of the candidates running to take George Voinovich's seat in the US Senate.

66% don't know enough about Rob Portman to have an opinion, 62% are ambivalent toward Jennifer Brunner, and 55% don't take a stance on Lee Fisher.

Portman has the early advantage, leading Brunner 38-37 and Fisher 41-36. That is largely due to a 37-25 edge against both Democratic candidates with independents.

Given the obscurity of all the candidates the key to this race may be how Ohio voters feel about Barack Obama, and that's not very good. 53% of the state disapproves of the President's job performance with only 40% giving him good marks. Portman's lead may be more a reflection of that and a good political climate for Republicans than anything else.

Ohio's not particularly taken with any of its politicians right now. 42% of voters disapprove of Voinovich to only 33% approving, and for Sherrod Brown it's 32% approving and 39% disapproving.


The health care bill passed Sunday night is not faring particularly well in the state. 54% of voters say they're opposed to it with only 39% in support and independents are particularly strong in their opposition, going against it by a 64/29 margin.

"None of the *candidates* in Ohio is really standing out right now," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "But if Barack Obama's numbers in the state remain this low it's not likely to elect a Democratic Senator this year. His popularity could be the deciding factor in this race."

PPP surveyed 630 Ohio voters on March 20th and 21st. The margin of error for the survey is +/-3.9%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
