

# SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS 2009 GAME NOTES

Friday, September 11th, 2009 Texas League North Division Finals - Naturals Lead Best-of-Five Series 2-0 Arvest Ballpark Springdale, AR

## NORTHWEST ARKANSAS NATURALS (37-33 Second Half, 73-67 Regular Season) $^{(a)}$

### SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (33-37 Second Half, 71-69 Regular Season) RHP BRANDON DICKSON (8-10, 3.78 ERA) vs. LHP ROWDY HARDY (4-4, 2.92 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to the Texas League Playoffs and Game Three in the Best-of-Five North Division Finals, between the Northwest Arkansas Naturals and your Springfield Cardinals. With the Naturals leading the series 2-0, the Cards must win to stay alive in the playoffs. Should they win the next three games at Arvest Ballpark, their next home game would be on Friday, September 18th, which would be game three of the Texas League Championship Series. Tickets would go on sale on Monday, by calling (417) 863-2143.

VS THE NATURALS: With wins of 6-0 and 12-7 respectively, the Naturals have a 2-0 lead in the best-of-five series. After winning the final three head-to-head meetings of the regular season, the Naturals have now beaten the Cardinals five straight times. During the regular season, the Cards went just 14-18 against the Naturals. They had the same record at Hammons Field (7-9), that they did here at Arvest Ballpark (7-9).

BRANDON DICKSON: Making his first appearance in the playoffs, after making 20 starts and 28 total appearances...in seven appearances and six starts against the Naturals, went 2-3 with a 3.49 ERA, allowing 18 runs (15 earned) on 41 hits over 38 2/3 innings..in last outing overall, allowed five runs on nine hits over 5 2/3 innings in a no-decision vs Arkansas on 9/5...in 2008, split time between Palm Beach (7-8, 3.51 ERA, 23 G, 17 GS) and Springfield (3-2, 6.75 ERA, 6 GS)...originally signed by St. Louis back in 2006 as an unrestricted free agent ... ROWDY HARDY: Making his first postseason appearance after appearing in 11 games, ten starts for the Naturals in 2009...in four appearances this year vs Cards, went 2-1 with a 4.13 ERA, allowing 11 runs on 27 hits over 24 innings...in last start overall, allowed six runs on eight hits over 4 1/3 innings in a loss at Arkansas on 9/3...opened the year on the DL after suffering an elbow injury during Spring Training...pitched for Class-A Wilmington of the Carolina League to open the 2009 season, going 3-1 with a 1.88 ERA in 12 games (six starts)...in 2008, pitched for Northwest Arkansas, going 6-11 with a 4.97 ERA in 28 games (27 starts)...against Springfield in 2008, went 1-1 with a 3.64 ERA in eight starts...played college ball at Austin Peay State University...originally signed as a Free Agent by Kansas City in 2006 ...

LAST GAME: After getting blanked in game one, the Redbird offense exploded early, but couldn't hold off the Northwest Arkansas bats, as the Naturals rallied for a 12-7 win on Thursday at Hammons Field. Kurt Mertins drove in four runs, including the tie-breaking run in the sixth against Casey Mulligan (0-1). Naturals' reliever Chad Orvella (1-0) gave up two runs over 3 1/3 innings, but picked up the win. Northwest Arkansas hit four home runs and pounded out a total of 14 hits. Aaron Hartsock kept the Springfield bats quiet over the final 2 1/3 innings, earning the save. Springfield got three hits from both Andrew Brown and Tyler Henley. Pete Kozma drove in three for the Cards, while Tony Cruz and Brown both knocked in a pair.

REGULAR SEASON WRAP: With Monday's come-from-behind 3-2 win over the Arkansas Travelers, the Cards finished the regular season at 71-69 and with a second-half record of 33-37. Thanks to winning four out of their last six games at home, the Cards finish with a 41-29 home record, but had just a 30-40 record away from Hammons Field. Springfield was led at the plate by Tyler Henley's .303 average and Steven Hill's 19 home runs and 64 RBIs. Trey Hearne led the Cards in wins (12) and ERA (2.82), while Brandon Dickson led in strikeouts (112) and Francisco Samuel led in saves (22)

SPARKS I-70 MEMORIES DOESN'T IT ?: Hopefully this head-to-head meeting will create some long-lasting memories, without the help of Don Denkinger and Jorge Orta. This series is the first-ever meeting in the post-season between these two Double-A affiliates. Both franchises are making their second respective appearances in the post-season. Springfield defeated Tulsa 3-0 in the North Division Finals back in 2007, before falling to San Antonio (3-1) in the Texas League Championship Series. Northwest Arkansas was swept 3-0 by eventual champion Arkansas, last season.

DOWN SOUTH: The San Antonio Missions bounced back for a 4-2 victory on Thursday, evening the best-of-five series at one game apiece. The series will now shift to Midland for the next three games (if necessary). Midland last won the crown in 2005, while San Antonio's last pennant came in 2007, when they defeated Springfield 3-1. The winner of this series will host games one and two of the Texas League Championship Series on Tuesday, September 15th and Wednesday, September 16th, before the series returns to the North representative city on Friday, September 18th for game three.

MEMPHIS UPDATE: The Memphis Redbirds scored five runs in the ninth inning, coming from behind to drop Albuquerque by a score of 8-6. Pete Parise pitched a scoreless ninth inning to earn the save and give Memphis a 2-0 lead in the best-of-five. Mark Hamilton drove in a pair with two hits, while Tyler Greene homered and also had two hits. The series now shifts to Memphis where the Redbirds will try to polish off the Isotopes tonight. Evan MacLane will get the start for the Redbirds, who would potentially meet the winner of the Sacramento/Tacoma series in the Pacific Coast League Finals.

CROWN ROYALS: Baseball America tabs just three players on the Northwest Arkansas roster, as being top 30 prospects within the Kansas City system: RHP Blake Wood (#10), OF David Lough (#15) and RHP Juan Abreu (#25).
