An International Mother Language Day will be proclaimed with a view to pursuing the Organization's work in favour of linguistic and cultural diversity and multilingualism in all fields of competence and that the proposed International Mother Language Day be observed on 21 February every year in the Member States and at UNESCO Headquarters.

Explanatory note

<u>Considering</u> that languages are at the very heart of UNESCO's objectives and that they are the most powerful instruments of preserving and developing our tangible and intangible heritage,

<u>Bearing in mind</u> also that all moves to promote the dissemination of mother tongues will serve not only to encourage linguistic diversity and multilingual education but also to development fuller awareness of linguistic and cultural traditions throughout the world and to inspire solidarity based on understanding, tolerance and dialogue,

<u>Considering</u> consequently that one of the most effective ways to promote and develop mother tongues is the establishment of an "International Mother Language Day" with a view to organizing various activities in the Member States and an exhibition at UNESCO Headquarters on that same day,

<u>Recognizing</u> the unprecedented sacrifice made by Bangladesh for the cause of mother language on 21 February 1952,

Noting that this idea has not yet been adopted at the international level,

<u>Proposes</u> that 21 February be proclaimed "International Mother Language Day" throughout the world to commemorate the martyrs who sacrificed their lives on this very date in 1952.
