PAC-10 SENDS RECORD NINE TEAMS INTO POSTSEASON ACTION

UCLA captured the Pacific Life Pac-10 title and earned the Pac-10's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament. The Bruins, who captured their third consecutive Pac-10 regular season crown, and 30th league title overall, enter the NCAA Tournament as the top seed in the West Regional... Five additional Pac-10 teams (STANFORD, WASHINGTON STATE, USC, OREGON and ARIZONA) were at-large selections, giving the Pac-10 a record-tying six teams in the NCAA Tournament (also achieved in 2002 and 2007)... ARIZONA STATE and CALIFORNIA will participate in the NIT, while WASHINGTON hosts CBI action. That gives the Pac-10 a record nine teams in postseason play. The previous high was seven on four occasions (1990, 1994, 1997, 2002)... The 2007-08 Pac-10 season has arguably been the most competitive in league history. For the first time in Pac-10 history, nine league teams finished regular season play with a winning record.

Tournament highlights... Close calls as three games were decided by three points each, including the Championship game. That's the highest number of games decided by three or fewer points in 11 Pac-10 Tournaments. Another game was decided by four points, while a fifth game was decided by five points... UCLA's three-point win was the closest margin of victory ever for the Championship game. Prior to this year's Tournament, the average margin of victory in the Championship game for the previous 10 Pac-10 Tournaments was 16.6 points... Arizona State freshman G **James Harden** set a Pac-10 Tournament single-game record with seven steals against USC... Stanford sophomore F **Brook Lopez** became the 11th player to score 30 or more points in a Tournament game with 30 points against Washington State... Stanford sophomore C **Robin Lopez** tied a Tournament record with nine blocked shots in three games... The soldout crowd of 18,997 that attended the semifinals tied a Tournament attendance record, matching the same total that attended the 2002 Championship game.

ARIZONA

NCAA Tournament Record: 41-25. 27th appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish: NCAA Champions (1997)

- Arizona is making its 24th consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Freshman G **Jerryd Bayless** set an Arizona freshman record with 581 points this season. He shot .408 (58-142) from three-point range and .837 (185-221) from the free throw line. His 221 free throw attempts were second most in the Pac-10 behind UCLA's Kevin Love (232 attempts).
- Sophomore F **Chase Budinger** has posted 1,044 career points, becoming the 42nd player in school history to reach 1,000 career points.
- Sophomore F **Jordan Hill** leads the league in field goal percentage (.622). Only three other Wildcats have ever led the league in that category - Pete Williams (1985), Brian Williams (1991) and Channing Frye (2002).
- The Wildcats have three players that are ranked among the league's top 10 in minutes played per game - Bayless (35.6 mpg/2nd), Budinger (35.2/4th) and **Jawaan McClellan** (34.9/6th).



OREGON

NCAA Tournament Record: 12-8. 10th appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish: NCAA Champions (1939)

- Senior F **Maarty Leunen** is just the second player in school history with 1,000 career points and 875 career rebounds. He needs four more rebounds to be the 25th player in Pac-10 history to record 900 rebounds.
- The Ducks have four players ranked among the league's top 16 in scoring - No. 8 **Malik Hairston** (16.1 ppg), No. 10 Leunen (15.2 ppg), No. 13 **Tajuan Porter** (13.8 ppg), No. 16 **Bryce Taylor** (13.0 ppg).
- Hairston ranks eighth on the school's career scoring list with 1,620 points.
- Oregon leads the league in three-point field goal percentage (.401) and three-pointers made per game (8.71 pg). The Ducks set a school single-game record with 18 three-pointers at California (Feb. 9).
- Head coach **Ernie Kent** won his 300th game as a Division I head coach when Oregon defeated Arizona State 67-61 on March 6. Kent, just the second man to win 200 games as coach of the Ducks, now has 211 wins in 11 seasons in Eugene to go with 90 wins in six years while head coach at Saint Mary's. Kent needs just one more win to match Basketball Hall of Famer Howard Hobson as Oregon's all-time winningest coach.



STANFORD

NCAA Tournament Record: 19-14. 16th appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish: NCAA Champions (1942)

- The Cardinal are making their 13th NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 14 years.
- Sophomore F **Brook Lopez** has scored in double figures in each of the last 19 games. He leads the team with 19.2 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. Both numbers would rank among the league's top five, however he would need to play in three more games in order to qualify for the league's statistical rankings.
- Sophomore C **Robin Lopez** ranks second all-time at Stanford with 148 career blocked shots.
- Junior G **Mitch Johnson** leads the Pac-10 with 4.82 assists per game. The only other Stanford players ever to lead the league in assists were Marcus Lollie (1992) and Brevin Knight (1996 and 1997)
- The Cardinal finished their home slate with a 16-1 record. The highest single-season home win total in school history. Stanford has produced 10 or more home wins in each of the last 15 seasons. The Cardinal are 63-11 (.851) at Maples Pavilion over the last five seasons.



UCLA

NCAA Tournament Record: 94-34. 42nd appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish: NCAA Champions (1964-65, 1967-73, 1975, 1995)

- UCLA has posted 30 or more wins for a school-record three consecutive seasons. Over the last three seasons, the Bruins have posted a record of 93-16 (.853).
- Freshman C **Kevin Love** was named the Pac-10 Player of the Year - just the second time a Pac-10 freshman earned the honor (California's Shareef Abdur-Rahim won it as a freshman in 1996). He scored in double figures in each game this season and posted 20 double-doubles.
- Love has grabbed 362 rebounds this season. That's more than any Bruin since Bill Walton had 398 in 1974.
- Junior F **Josh Shipp** (1,220 pts) and G **Darren Collison** (1,084 pts) each went over 1,000 points for their careers.
- Collison earned Pac-10 Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors after averaging 20.0 points, 2.7 assists, 1.7 steals and turned the ball over just twice in 110 minutes of action.

USC

NCAA Tournament Record: 11-15. 14th appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish - tie for 3rd (1940)

- Freshman G **O.J. Mayo** ranks second in the league in scoring at 20.8 ppg - tops among all Pac-10 freshmen. His 664 points this season are a USC freshman single-season record, passing former Trojan Harold Miner who scored 578 points in 1990. His season point total ranks third all-time on USC's single-season list.
- Mayo holds the USC freshman record with 86 three-pointers.
- Sophomore F **Taj Gibson** leads the Pac-10 in blocks (81 blocks/2.53 per game). His 150 career blocked shots rank second all-time for the Trojans.
- USC underclassmen handle much of the scoring. In 32 games, USC freshmen scored 1,176 of 2,210 points (53.2 percent), and the freshmen and sophomores accounted for 2,116 of 2,210 points (95.7 percent).
- USC leads the league in defensive field goal percentage (.391).



WASHINGTON STATE

NCAA Tournament Record: 4-5. 6th appearance. Last appearance - 2007
Best NCAA finish - 2nd (1940)

- The Cougars have posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since Jack Friel's teams posted four straight 20-plus win seasons from 1939-42.
- The Cougars have drawn a record 120,083 fans (9,237 per game). It's the second consecutive season over 100,000 fans, and third time in school history.
- Senior G **Derrick Low** ranks fourth on WSU's all-time three-point list with 213 treys.
- Senior G **Kyle Weaver** is believed to be the first player in Pac-10 history to record 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists, 150 steals and 75 blocked shots.
- The Cougars lead the league in turnover margin (+3.03) and post a league-low 10.3 turnovers. The Cougars have turned the ball over 10 or fewer times in 14 of the last 20 games.

ARIZONA STATE

NIT Tournament Record: 3-9. 10th appearance. Last appearance - 2005
Best NIT finish - 1-1 (1983, 1992, 2000)

- Finishing 9-9 in Pac-10 play was a seven-win improvement over last year's 2-16 season. ASU is the fifth team in 30 years of Pac-10 play to go from a last-place finish to a .500 record.
- Freshman G **James Harden**'s 17.6 points per game is second-best in ASU freshmen history, while his 68 steals are also a school freshman record. At 2.19 steals per game, he's attempting to become the fifth freshman to lead the league in steals - Jason Kidd (3.8 spg/1993), Baron Davis, UCLA (2.4 spg/1998), Errick Craven USC (2.1 spg/2002) and Gabe Pruitt, USC (1.9 spg/2005).
- Freshman G **Ty Abbott** holds ASU's freshmen record for three-pointers with 61.



CALIFORNIA

NIT Tournament Record: 10-4. 6th appearance. Last appearance - 2000
Best NIT finish - Champions (1999)

- Sophomore F **Ryan Anderson** became the first Bear ever to post 600 points and 300 rebounds in a season. Currently leading the league in scoring (21.3 ppg), he is looking to become the Bears' seventh conference scoring champion in the past 15 years.
- Cal is shooting 78.0 percent from the charity stripe and is on pace to set a single-season school record, eclipsing the mark of 76.9 percent set last year.
- Sophomore G **Patrick Christopher** has reached double digits in 24 games this year. His 15.8 ppg is 10.6 ppg more than he averaged a year ago - the highest increase for any Pac-10 player this year..



WASHINGTON

CBI Tournament Record: 0-0. First appearance.

- Junior F **Jon Brockman** ranks No. 12 on UW season list with 546 points, and is No. 5 among all-time Husky single-season rebounders with 358. His 22 double-doubles are the highest total, tying Steve Hawes' 22 in 1972. Brockman is vying to become the first player to lead all Pac-10 rebounders in consecutive seasons since Stanford's Adam Keefe in 1991 and 1992. Brockman sprained an ankle in the season finale at WSU and did not play in the Pac-10 Tournament. That broke a streak of 96 consecutive games played for Brockman.
- Senior G **Ryan Appleby** set a pair of Washington records this season - three-pointers in a game (9 at Oregon State) and career three-pointers (230). He already owns the single-season mark of 84 set last season.

PAC-10 MISCELLANY...

The Postseason: With six teams selected for the NCAA Tournament, the Pac-10 is sending four or more teams into the Tournament for the 14th time in 15 years... With Oregon at 9-9 and Arizona at 8-10 in league play, this marks the first time a Pac-10 team with a .500 record or sub-.500 record has made the Tournament field... Eight of the 10 Pac-10 institutions have appeared in the NCAA Tournament over the previous three years... Over the last seven NCAA Tournaments, the Pac-10 has posted a 52-33 (.612) record and has had 15 teams reach the Sweet Sixteen... With 15 national titles, the Pac-10 owns more NCAA basketball titles than any other conference. Five different Pac-10 schools have captured the national title... Three different Pac-10 schools have won NIT titles.

Fabulous Freshmen: Four Pac-10 freshman are among the top six in the league in scoring - USC's **O.J. Mayo** (20.8 ppg/2nd), Arizona's **Jerryd Bayless** (20.0/3rd), Arizona State's **James Harden** (17.6 ppg/4th) and UCLA's **Kevin Love** (17.1 ppg/6th). Prior to this year, only seven Pac-10 freshman had averaged 17.0 points or more... Three different freshmen scored 30 or more points in a game 11 times this season (four times each by Mayo and Love, once by Arizona State's **Ty Abbott**). The 39-point effort by Bayless against Arizona State (Feb. 9) ranks as the second best output by a freshman in league history... A record five different freshmen were tabbed Pac-10 Player of the Week this season.

The Rankings: Seven different Pac-10 teams have appeared in the *Associated Press* Top 25 this season (highest ranking included) - Arizona (17), Arizona State (22), Oregon (11), Stanford (7), UCLA (2), USC (18), and Washington State (4).

Home Sweet Home: The Pac-10 set an average attendance mark with 8,826 fans this season. The previous season-best average was 8,388 fans set during the 2000 season... In non-conference play, Pac-10 teams combined to go 67-9 (882) at home. However, it was a different story in league play as the home teams were able to manage a 48-42 (.533) record in league play. It was lowest win total for the home team in Pac-10 history, edging the 49-41 record compiled during the 1980-81 season.

PAC-10 IN NCAA TOURNAMENT PLAY

The Pacific-10 Conference has won more NCAA basketball titles (15) than any other conference in the country . . . Oregon's Tall Firs won the first NCAA Championship in 1939. Stanford claimed the national title in 1942, and California took the crown in 1959 . . . UCLA established a basketball dynasty that included 10 titles in 12 seasons and a winning streak of seven consecutive NCAA crowns. The Bruins' 11 basketball championships are double what any other school has ever won . . . In 1997, Arizona became the fifth different Pac-10 institution to capture the NCAA basketball title.
