Milwaukee's Sandy Botham has coached more Horizon League games (168) than anyone in League history. Now entering her 12th season at UWM, Botham has 118 League victories, seven behind Green Bay's Kevin Borseth for the top spot on that list. Botham led the Panthers to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history in 2006, following a trip to the 2001 national summit. Borseth compiled a 125-13 loop ledger in his eight seasons on the Phoenix bench, a .906 winning percentage to go with nine consecutive postseason appearances (seven NCAA, two WNIT).

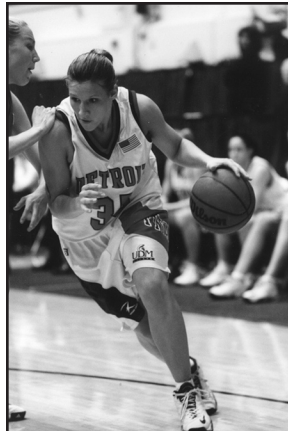

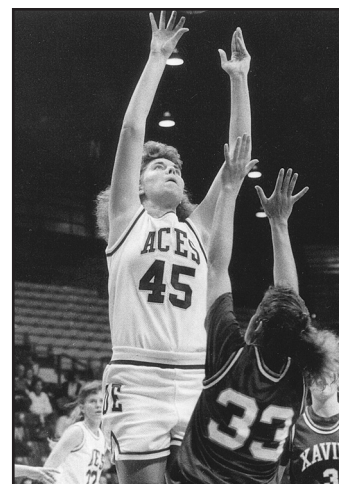
