Regional Rivalries

The annual Bronze Boot match between regional rivals Saint Louis University and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville traditionally represented some of the most exciting soccer in St. Louis.

The Billikens continued their domination of the series by blanking the Cougars 1-0 in the 1998 match at the Anheuser-Busch Conference & Sports Centre. Freshman Marty Tappel scored in the 96th minute to back the shutout goalkeeping of Paul Nagy and John Politis. Senior marking back Ken Costello led an airtight Billiken defense.

In 2000, the match was to be played as a spring game in April, but the Billikens had to cancel because of injury problems. The match was played as an August preseason game for the previous two years after a one-year hiatus in 1996. The last regular-season Bronze Boot match was played on Friday, Sept. 8, 1995.

SIUE moved to NCAA Division II status in 1996 and joined a new league, the Great Lakes Valley Conference. NCAA scheduling regulations brought an end to the regular-season competition.

Though Saint Louis leads the series and has won the last 15 contests, the game had special appeal for the local crowds as well as the local players on each squad.

In the past, the Bills also had challenged NCAA Division II foe Missouri-St. Louis in the St. Louis Cup. The teams last vied for the Cup in 1990 when NCAA scheduling requirements caused the suspension of that series. Although the teams played again in the 2004 regular season opener, the Cup was not at stake.
