A brick and flint building in a simple neo-Norman style with triplets of stepped lancets. The church appears to have been extended at the sanctuary end and to have had a completely new roof and windows. According to D R Elleray it was designed by W Romaine Walker but this can not be verified and the building does not seem to be of the quality or calibre one would expect of an established London architect with a national practice.
