

A11 Fiveways to Thetford Pre Orders Exhibition July 2008

You are invited to attend an Exhibition to review updated developments of the proposed A11 Fiveways to Thetford Improvement scheme.

Following feedback from the earlier Public Consultation held February 2001 and Preferred Route Announcement in November 2001, we have been progressing this scheme which now includes improving Fiveways roundabout and carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment. We would like to give you this opportunity to review our plans in more detail.

Our exhibition will provide you with clarification of our proposals and allow for further minor modifications to be made, before the publication of Draft Orders.

It is our intention to publish the Environmental Statement and draft Orders this Autumn 2008. Depending on the number and nature of any objections to the proposals, a Public Inquiry may then be held. This would be held before an independent inspector who will then make recommendations to the Secretary of State. After consideration of any objections, representations, expressions of support and the inspector's report, the Secretary of State will decide whether the Orders for the road should be made.


We will be at the exhibition with our consultant Parsons Brinckerhoff Ltd to answer your questions and explain how the design details have been decided.

Safe driving at roadworks

Remember that tiredness can kill. Take regular breaks from driving.



During 2006 two workers were killed and 19 seriously injured in the course of their work on Highways Agency roads.

For the safety of all road users and roadworkers, when you are approaching roadworks: ◆ Keep within the speed limit – it is there for your safety. ◆ Get into the correct lane in good time – don't keep switching. ◆ Concentrate on the road ahead, not the roadworks. ◆ Be alert for works' traffic leaving or entering roadworks. ◆ Keep a safe distance – there could be queues in front. ◆ Observe all signs – they are there to help you.
