UPDATED INFORMATION ON TORNADOES FROM NWS STORM SURVEYS...

INFORMATION FROM NWS SURVEY OF AREAS JUST WEST OF ROCKPORT: THE SURVEY TEAM FOUND A TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN IN A SUBDIVISION ROUGHLY 4 MILES WEST-NORTHWEST OF ROCKPORT...ALONG COPANO BAY. THE TORNADO WAS ON THE GROUND FOR 3.75 MILES TRAVELING SOUTHEAST AND ENDING NEAR BYPASS 35 AND 16TH STREET...AND HAD A MAXIMUM WIDTH OF 3/10THS OF A MILE. SEVERAL HOMES WERE DAMAGED..AN RV FLIPPED...4 BOATS DAMAGED. A HOME WEATHER STATION RECORDED A PEAK WIND TO 103 MPH BEFORE FAILING. OVER 20 LARGE HIGH TENSION POLES WERE SNAPPED COMPLETELY OFF ALONG HIGHWAY 1069. A BUSINESS ALONG 1069 HAD A GARAGE COMPLETELY DESTROYED AND VEHICLES MOVED SEVERAL YARDS. AN 18 WHEELER WAS TIPPED OVER AT HWY 35 AND 16TH STREET. HUNDREDS OF TREES WERE DAMAGED ALONG THE PATH. MAXIMUM WINDS OF 115-120 MPH (EF-2) WERE ESTIMATED IN A CORE FROM THE SOUTHSIDE OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD WHERE THE TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN...SOUTHEAST TO FM 1069. SPORADIC EF-0 TO EF-1 DAMAGE WAS OBSERVED ELSEWHERE.

INFORMATION FROM NWS SURVEY OF AREA JUST JUST NORTH OF CHAPMAN RANCH: THE SURVEY TEAM FOUND A TORNADO TOUCHED DOWN 1/4 MILE SOUTH OF HWY 286 AND CR 18...JUST NORTH OF CHAPMAN RANCH. THE TORNADO WAS ON THE GROUND FOR 1/2 MILE TRAVELING NORTHEAST THROUGH CROP FIELDS AND HAD A WIDTH ROUGHLY 10-20 YARDS WIDE BASED UPON CROP DAMAGE OBSERVED. MAX WIND SPEEDS OF 70-80 MPH WERE ESTIMATED.

INFORMATION FROM NWS SURVEY OF NAS CORPUS CHRISTI:
THE SURVEY TEAM ESTIMATED WIND SPEEDS OF 80-90 MPH OCCURRED AT NAS
CORPUS CHRISTI. WIND DAMAGE WAS CONSISTENT WITH STRAIGHT-LINE
WINDS. FOUR RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WERE FLIPPED AND SEVERAL OTHERS
MOVED. 6 PEOPLE WERE INJURED...WITH ONE IN CRITICAL CONDITION.
ALSO...DEBRIS FROM A BOAT BARN WAS BLOWN INTO THE LAGUNA
MADRE...WITH ACTUAL BOATS BLOWN INTO A PARKING LOT. THE SURVEY TEAM
OBSERVED NUMEROUS TREES DAMAGED ON NAS CORPUS CHRISTI.

INFORMATION FROM NWS SURVEY OF PADRE AND MUSTANG ISLANDS:
THE TEAM ESTIMATED WIND SPEEDS OF 80-90 MPH OCCURRED ON PADRE
ISLAND. WIND DAMAGE WAS CONSISTENT WITH STRAIGHT-LINE WINDS.
SHINGLES WERE BLOWN OFF A BANK ON HWY 358 ON PADRE ISLAND. A 5 STORY
SECTION OF AN EXTERIOR WALL OF THE HOLIDAY INN ON PADRE ISLAND
COLLAPSED FROM THE WINDS. ON MUSTANG ISLAND SEVERAL LARGE POWER
POLES WERE SNAPPED ON HWY 361. IN ADDITION A LARGE SIDE OF A BRICK
WALL AT THE SEAGULL CONDOMINIUMS COLLAPSED.

INFORMATION FROM NWS STORM SURVEY OF ARANSAS PASS:
THE SURVEY TEAM ESTIMATED WIND SPEEDS OF 70-80 MPH OCCURRED AT
ARANSAS PASS. WIND DAMAGE WAS CONSISTENT WITH STRAIGHT-LINE WINDS.
A CHURCH IN ARANSAS PASS HAD A PORTION OF THE ROOF PEELED OFF. A
TRAILER WAS ALSO FLIPPED OVER. NUMEROUS LARGE TREES WERE DAMAGED
THROUGHOUT ARANSAS PASS.

IN ADDITION...HEAVY **RAINFALL** PRODUCED **FLASH** FLOODING IN LAREDO FORCING THE CLOSURE OF THREE INTERSECTIONS...INCLUDING MANN ROAD. DIME SIZE **HAIL** AND WIND GUSTS TO 52 MPH WERE REPORTED IN THE CITY.

TWO MESOSCALE CONVECTIVE SYSTEMS MERGED ACROSS SOUTH TEXAS DURING THE LATE EVENING HOURS OF JUNE 2ND. STRONG TO SEVERE WIND GUSTS AND DAMAGE WAS REPORTED. BELOW ARE SELECTED MEASURED PEAK WIND GUSTS AS WELL AS SELECTED RAINFALL TOTALS FOR THIS EVENT.
