State of work in Committee	Latest adopted text: Resolution 1748 (2010) 6-7 September 2010 – The Committee heard a statement by Mr de Puig, Chairman of the Sub-committee on the Middle East, and held an exchange of views with Mr Al-Salhi and Mr Kokaly, members of the Palestinian Legislative Council (PLC) and Mrs Frankel, Ambassador of Israel. 2010 4th part-session – The Sub-Committee heard a statement by its Chair, held an exchange of views with the participation of Mr Plesner and Mrs Kirshenbaum, members of the Knesset and Mr Abu-Shahla, and Mr Salhi, members of the PLC, agreed on pursuing dialogue on "practical issues" and asked the delegations of the Knesset and the PLC to contact the Secretariat with concrete proposals. 18 November 2010 – The Committee heard a statement by Mr de Puig, Chair of the sub-committee on the Middle East, held an exchange of views with Mr Rotem, member of the Knesset, Mr Salhi and Mr Assaf, members of the PLC, and agreed to hold a meeting of the Sub-Committee on the Middle East in the morning of 14 December 2010, to discuss specific issues. 14 December 2010 – The Sub-Committee heard a statement by its Vice-Chair, on behalf of the Chair; followed presentations on issues related to water by Mr Cohen, expert for the Knesset and Dr. Aleiwi, expert for the PLC; held an exchange of views with Mr Plesner, member of the Knesset, Dr. Sabella, Mr. Salhi and Mr. Assaf, members of the PLC; agreed to pursue discussions, during the January 2011 part-session, on a number of concrete water treatment projects, on projects to develop the Eastern aquifer and on projects to reduce water leakages, to be proposed by each delegation.
