

Bramcote Hills Sport and Community College (11-18 community school)

The White Hills Park Federation is made up of three secondary Schools – Alderman White School & Language College, Bramcote Park Business and Enterprise School and Bramcote Hills Sports and Community College - all under one Governing Body and led by the executive head teacher Kevin Dean.

Recent refurbishment work has been taking place at the Bramcote Hills Upper School building. During the course of this work fundamental problems have been uncovered with the structural integrity of the concrete which is used in the building in question.

The Bramcote Hills site consists of a number of separate and interconnected teaching blocks built by different methods of construction over the years and consequently not all of the teaching areas are affected. In view of the potential risk involved in continuing to use the block where the structural integrity of the concrete has been compromised it has been decided to close this area with immediate effect.

For September 2008, plans have been made to maximise the use of other teaching areas on the Bramcote Hills site and across the other two schools in the federation. A major benefit of the federation is that it readily facilitates the management and sharing of facilities and resources to minimise any disruption to the students' education.

Additional building investigations are underway to determine the long-term implications for the school.
