Angling: Rocky shore of Miyakejima Island, rock reef of Mikura Island, Onoharajima Island (ferryboat), coastal waters of Miyakejima Island (boat fishing)

Measurement: Ako Elementary School Gymnasium

Awarding/Social gathering: Ako Elementary School Gymnasium

3. Category

Class A

Category 1: Ishidai (parrot fish) (40cm or longer)

Category 2: Ishigakidai (striped beakperch) (40cm or longer)

Category 3: Mejina (opaleye) (30cm or longer)

Category 4: Budai (scarid) (30cm or longer)

Category 5: Other fish * (1kg or heavier)

Category 6: Female anglers * (all fish)

Category 7: Elementary schoolchild anglers * (all fish)

*: excluding moray, shark, ray, globefish

Class B

Category 1: Boat fishing (for the heaviest fish)

4. Competition Rules

- (1) For Categories 1 to 4 in Class A, winners will be determined according to the length of fish they catch. However, if fish of the same length are caught by two or more anglers, the one who has caught the heaviest one will win.
- (2) For Categories 5 to 7 in Class A, winners will be determined according to the weight of fish they catch. However, if fish of the same weight are caught by two or more anglers, the one who has caught the longest one will win.
- (3) One applicant may enter two or more different categories (excluding "boat fishing" and "child" categories).
- (4) Measurement

Boat fishing: The caught fish must be presented for weigh-in between 3:00 p.m. and 3.30 p.m.

Surf fishing: The caught fish must be presented for weigh-in between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.

* The above times must be observed strictly.

5. Participation fee

Adult:¥3,000

Child:¥1,500 (to be accompanied by parents or guardians)

The expenses for ferryboat and boat fishing must be paid by each participant.

6. Awards

Top three winners in each category will be awarded with a certificate of commendation and an extra prize to be presented (new fishing gear, etc.)

<The guideline for safety tourism in Miyakejima- Island>

Please follow our instructions for your safety in traveling around Miyakejima-Island.

After the eruption of volcano in 2000, the volcano gas discharge still continues in the island, and various measures have been introduced by Miyake Village in order to keep your safety from the toxic gas.

Please keep your attention on the danger of volcano gas and follow the rules.

Thank you for your understanding on this matter.

The Instructions:

1 Keep away from the entry-restricted districts.

There are 3 types of entry-restricted districts in the Island, in proportion to the density of sulfur dioxide;

- Off-limits zone

"Tachiiri-kinshi kuiki"(立入禁止区域)

- Danger zone

"Kiken kuiki"(危険区域)

- the highly dioxide density district

"Ko-nodo kuiki"(高濃度地区)

It is banned to enter all of these three districts, except for passing through the highly dioxide density district.

You can confirm the districts with the map below.

2 Always have a hazard mask with you

In the Island, you are required to carry a hazard mask with you. In case you have a subjective symptoms such as a fit of coughing and bad smells, put on the mask immediately, without warning and alarm are raised.

This mask has a high effect to keep you from breathing the high density of sulfur dioxide. It is quite different from those handy masks such as for pollen or dust.

You can buy one at the reception desk at Takeshiba pier on the day of tour. We have two kinds of masks;


The regular hazard mask $\frac{1}{2}$ 2420- (tax included) The disposable hazard mask $\frac{1}{2}$ 1575- (tax included)

3 Evacuation with calm

An alarm on the density of sulfur dioxide will be raised in each local area.

Please confirm with the map in advance which area you are, and once the alarm is raised, listen carefully to the instructions over the island wide public address system.


If the alarm is on the broadcast, put on your hazard mask and evacuate to safer places immediately.
