## **Biographical Information**

Eugene Remich Rice came to Denver in 1881 after having studied architecture at Cornell University in New York. He formed a partnership with Robert G. Balcomb in 1886 and opened their first office in the now demolished Tabor Block at 16th and Larimer Streets. The firm went on to design some of Denver's most elaborate examples of the Queen Anne style that still stand today. The Flower-Vaile House at 1610 Emerson St., the Bouvier-Lathrop House at 1600 Emerson St., the John S. Flower House at 1618 Ogden St., and the Dragon House at 1542 Williams St., are all examples of Balcomb and Rice's exuberant interpretation of the Queen Anne style. The first three are listed in the National Register of Historic Places and the last in the locally designed Wyman Historic District.

The firm's prosperity extended beyond the residential market to include a wide variety of buildings and structures throughout the city. The Denver Building Permit records credit the firm with a church addition, stores, terraces, barns, stables and grand stands. Regrettably, only the residential designs are currently identified in the list below.

Rice was a charter member of the Colorado A.I.A. and president of the Denver Sketch Club from 1889-90. The partnership of Balcomb and Rice continued until 1897, when Rice went into business for himself, designing up until his death at the age of 37 from pneumonia. He is buried at Fairmount Cemetery.
