NT 80.10 December 17, 1851 Z. Kaauwai, sworn: I know her pahale at Honolulu, Manaaiole its name; 7 houses stand there. Bounded mauka, vacant kula land; Waikiki, land purchased by Kapaakea and pahale of Kuhia [K/A; LCA 656]; makai, pahale of Kaiahua [LCA 1818 at Punchbowl & Beretania]; Ewa, Pauoa road and kula.

She received the parcel Manaluna from [her father] Aikanaka in 1837, and the parcel Manalalo came to her husband Kapaakea from Kamanawa. She occupies it without dispute.

Kaneakalani, sworn: I know her pahale at Honolulu that is bounded mauka, by the pa of the King, Pelekane its name; Waikiki, road to the seashore [?]; makai, Beretania St., Ewa, pa of Hueu [LCA 776]. She received this pa from [her father] Aikanaka and no one disputes it.

NT 359.10 "contd. from NT 80.10" April 28, 1854: Moehonua witness to Puamana: Recd. from kupuna.

Kekuanaoa's testimony in Equity 220 (p. 72):

... "Keohokalole received all the property of Naihe and Aikanaka." [i.e., the lands inherited from Kameeiamoku and Keawe-a-Heulu, Kamehameha's warrior chiefs and cousellors, which accounts for her extensive holdings at Mahele time]
