2008 Guest Speaker: Dr. James W. Moore

Newly-retired from a successful 22-year tenure as senior minister of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Houston, James W. "Jim" Moore currently serves as Minister in Residence at Highland Park United Methodist Church (HPUMC). Dr. Moore uses his talents at HPUMC teaching seasonal bible studies, preaching on occasion and continuing his thriving writing career.

A native of Memphis, Dr. Moore attended Lambuth College (Bachelor of Arts); The Methodist Theological School in Ohio (Masters of Divinity); and Centenary College (Doctor of Divinity). Early in his career, Dr. Moore served pastorates in Tennessee and Ohio. From 1972-84, Dr. Moore served Shreveport's First United Methodist Church as co-pastor, sharing the pulpit with Dr. D. L. Dykes. From 1984-2006, Dr. Moore served as

senior minister of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Houston, with a membership of more than 8,000 where his sermons were telecast each week and are available in print, tape, and on the Internet.

An award-winning and prolific author, Dr. Moore has also received numerous honors including the J. Henry Bowden, Sr. Preaching Award (recognition of outstanding preaching on moral issues); the John and Ruth Mount Alumni Award for Parish Ministry by The Methodist Theological School in Ohio; the Caring Spirit Award by The

Houston Medical Center's Institute of Religion; the R.E. Womack Achievement Award (Outstanding Alumnus) from Lambuth University; and a Sustaining Presence Award by Interfaith CarePartners.

A father and grandfather, Dr. Moore is married to the former June Daniels and they make their home at Heritage Ranch in Fairview, Texas.
