Full description of the decision

Decision: It is decided to add 55 kg to the minimum weight of the car which is 1200 kg. The total is 1255 kg. The current size of the 2 restrictors is kept (maximum diameter of 31.2 mm).

Reason: Adjustment of the performance of the cars further to the Brno event of 23 May.

Missions concerned

- 1) drawing up the technical definition of GT3 cars and/or intervention in the process of drawing up their final technical form,
- 2) amendment and/or adjustment of the performance parameters of the cars,
- 3) help the competitors or tuners optimise the performance of their cars in an equitable manner,
- 4) examination of any request for a technical change concerning the homologation form of a vehicle,
- 5) prohibition of any developments that would result in a significant increase in the costs of cars,
- 6) examination of any request from a competitor wishing to take part in an FIA event with a car complying with national regulations, as specified by the applicable sporting regulations.


