It is a way of learning in the competition of filmmaking with the best being short listed with awards to Be awarded on the 15th of October 2011

The Short film subject can be no less than 5 minutes and no more than 30 minutes, your film can be of the following genre all entries in the Junior Filmmaking awards category will be judged under the following.

The competition will close for entries on to the 15th July 2011, all entries received after this date but with postmarks before the 15th July will be excepted, entries with a post mark after the 15th July will not be excepted the notification of nominations will be approximately the 15th of September 2011.

The nominated movies will be screened during the festival and the winners will be informed at the awards ceremony on the 15th of October 2011.



Documentary (Short)

Documentary is a broad category of visual expression that is based on the Attempt, in one fashion or another, to document reality: a creative work of non-fiction, intended for cinema or TV release.

Music (Short)

Music is an art form, entertainment, or activity which involves organised sound And varies according to culture. Any film that makes use of music, in its Creation, performance, significance and even its definition, will be considered In this category.

Foreign Language (Short)

Any film in a language other than English, The Junior Filmmaker Award is given To the makers of the film but is considered an award for the country of origin.

Animation (Short)

Any type of film that is animated and under 30 minutes will be accepted into This category

(a) Feature films, documentaries and short subjects of any genre on 8mm, 16mm, 35mm, 70mm and DVD are selected by invitation, according to quality, from among Those shown at festivals, during the preceding three years.

(b) The organisers also welcome unsolicited submissions made in accordance with These regulations. The International Filmmaker Festival is competitive.

Entries must have been produced within the last three years. All films in a Language other than English must be subtitled in English, unless dialogue or Commentary is unnecessary for comprehension and appreciation. In the exceptional Event that an unsubtitled print is accepted, English dialogue lists are Required.

The International Filmmaker Festival reserves the right to use excerpts from Submitted work for promotional purposes only. The Festival is open to the Public. A substantial number of accredited national and international press, TV And film buyers and distributors also participate. Official or professional National organisations and individuals may submit feature and short films to the

Festival. Films submitted for preselection should arrive no later than 15th June 2011 and must be shipped as per instructions above. All shipping costs Of unsolicited films must be borne by the sender. Please note: it is not Possible for us to return any unsolicited tapes. It is the International Filmmaker Festival's policy not to offer comments and reasons for films not Selected for the programme.
