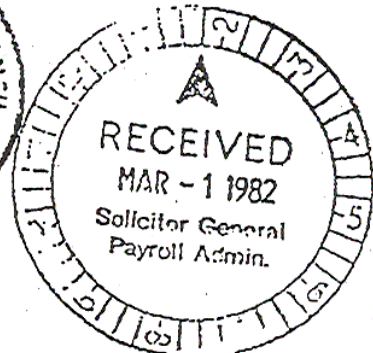
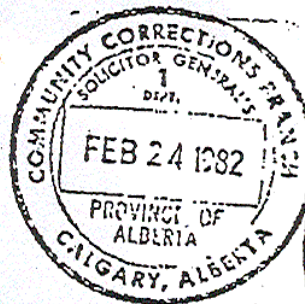

This correspondence is to confirm you have been chosen the successful candidate on the above-noted competition and we are prepared to offer you the position of Deputy Director of Operations (Senior Officer I (C) Social Science Family) at a starting salary of \$34,080.00 per annum (\$2,840.00 per month) commencing April 1, 1982.

It should be noted, as you are commencing in the latter half of our Managerial Appraisal period, you will NOT be eligible for the Managerial Merit adjustment on your anniversary date of June 1st, 1982, but you MAY be eligible for a partial Managerial Market adjustment.

Please report to [redacted], Acting Director, Calgary Correctional Centre for commencement at 8:15 on the morning of April 1, 1982. You will be required to sign various commencement documents, therefore, please ensure you have with you your birth certificate, medicare card, and social insurance number.

In addition to our offer of employment, we are prepared to pay the following:

- Cost of transporting your household effects from Lancaster Park to Calgary (Relocation information enclosed).
- One way economy airfare or mileage at the rate of \$.075 per kilometer for yourself and your family to travel from Edmonton to Calgary.
- Return economy airfare, or return mileage (at a rate of \$.075 per kilometer) and up to five (5) days subsistence (\$25.75 per day for yourself and your spouse) and hotel accommodation (on a receipt basis) or private accommodation (\$12.25 per night) to travel to Calgary for a house hunting trip.

- Real estate fees up to a maximum of 7% of the selling price of your residence, if the claim is supported by a receipt and the residence is listed within six months and sold within one year of April 1, 1982.
- Legal expenses up to a maximum of \$1,250.00 associated with a change of place of residence, if such claim is supported by a receipt and the legal expenses are incurred within one year of April 1, 1982.
- Incidental expenses associated with your change of residence to a maximum of \$1,075.00 supported by receipts. Refer to the attached relocation booklet to determine the admissible expenses permitted under this allowance.
- Up to fourteen (14) nights of temporary accommodation for yourself and immediate family upon arrival at Calgary. You will also be allowed fourteen (14) days subsistence at a rate of \$25.75 per day for yourself, \$13.50 per day for your wife and each child over nine (9) years of age at \$9.40 per day for each child nine (9) years of age and younger. If you have no dependents, or your immediate family is unable to accompany you, you may claim accommodation and subsistence up to a maximum of 30 days. It must be noted in either case that you will be reimbursed \$12.25 per night if private accommodation is used, rather than a hotel.
- You will be reimbursed by an expense account which you should submit after the temporary accommodation period is completed. If hotel accommodation has been used, receipts must be submitted with the expense account.

In view of the substantial investment by the Government in paying moving expenses to your new place of employment, we expect a commitment on your part of two (2) years of service. If you resign from the Government service prior to the end of this twenty four (24) month period, you will be required to repay the Government for a portion of your moving expenses based on the number of months left to be worked in the twenty-four (24) month period (ie. if 6 months left to be worked, 6/24 or 1/4 of the moving expense must be repaid).

Your Federal Government pension contributions are transferable to the Alberta Government Management Pension Plan. You may apply to have your pension contributions transferred once you commence employment with us.

It should be noted you will be required to serve a one (1) year probationary period as is the case with all new appointees to this classification. Your probation period will expire March 31, 1983.

Please confirm your acceptance of this offer by signing the enclosed copy of this letter and returning it to my attention.

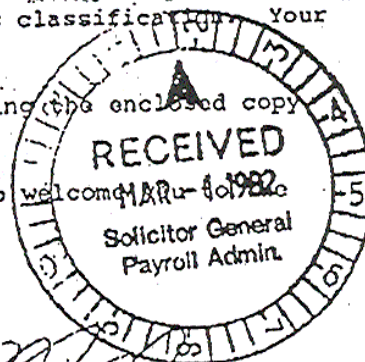
At this time, I would like to take the opportunity to welcome you to the staff of the Alberta Solicitor General.
