


Registration Transfer Policy

Registration funds are transferable from one financial member to another financial member, and one registered guest to another registered guest. The official conference registration transfer form is available from the Headquarters and may be obtained from the PBS web site. Written and signed permission from the transferor to the transferee is required for registration transfers.

A Brother can only transfer his personal registration. The deadline date for transfer is May 30, 2009. Any unforeseen situations after this date will be reviewed by the Office of the President.

Registration Refund Policy

Registration fees are eligible for a refund at a rate of 50% provided written notification is submitted to and received at Phi Beta Sigma headquarters with a postmark date no later than May 30, 2009.

Each delegate must complete the Delegate Certification Section on the registration form and have signed by both the chapter president and chapter secretary in order to be recognized as the chapter's delegate to the Conclave. A government-issued photo identification must be presented by the official delegate at the time of seating to be eligible to participate in the voting process.

Sigma Wellness

Sigma Wellness is a Men's Health Initiative that seeks to partner with community groups/organizations and health care institutions to reduce the incidence of health conditions that adversely affect Men of Color by utilizing education, screenings, civic networking and activities to encourage healthier living. There are four main components for this initiative Diet & Nutrition, Physical Fitness & Exercise, Sexual Health, Mental & Spiritual Health.

The Sigma Beta Club Program

The Sigma Beta Club is the Fraternity's youth development initiative established in the early 1950's. The Sigma Beta Programming includes promotion of social and economic justice, financial literacy, health and well-being. Our Sigma Beta Club Program also nurtures creativity, promotes academic achievement and reinforces social responsibility of young men from ages 8-18. We have over 100 active programs across the country.

The American Cancer Society

A National Partnership with the American Cancer Society where we focus on the most commonly diagnosed cancers among African-American men: prostate, lung and colorectal cancers; focus on influencing behavior and lifestyle change in the African-American community around diet, nutrition and tobacco consumption. Phi Beta Sigma also raises dollars annually through Relay for Life and other chapter events.

Sigma Economic Empowerment Development – (Project SEED)

S.E.E.D. is the Fraternity's financial literacy initiative that provides opportunities in financial management and home ownership. S.E.E.D. teaches fundamental fiscal management techniques to help students identify hidden financial resources. This initiative also helps position low-to-moderate income American families realize the dream of home ownership.

March of Dimes and Phi Beta Sigma Together Preventing Premature Births and Building Strong Fathers

Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. in partnership with March of Dimes work together to prevent premature births, teenage pregnancy and work to build strong fathers through promoting the March of Dimes Prematurity Campaign, donating funds to the March of Dimes through Walk America and sponsoring a Series of Preventing Teenage Pregnancy and Building Strong Fathers Seminars across the country.
