Did you know...

- the Harold K.L. Castle Foundation was founded in 1962 by Harold Kainalu Long Castle.
- Mr. Castle was the owner of Kaneohe Ranch and the land it occupied.
- the Foundation is the largest private foundation headquartered in Hawaii. We make grants statewide, not just in Windward Oahu.
- Since 2003, more than \$17 million was granted to organizations serving Windward Oahu and over \$9 million directed to public education.
- The foundation's mission is to close the achievement and preparation gaps in public education in Hawaii, restore nearshore marine ecosystems, and strengthen windward Oahu communities.
- the Foundation provides grants from \$500 to \$5,000 to Windward youth groups for activities that include community service.
- the Foundation does not make grants to individuals, nor does it fund endowments, conferences, vehicles, school computer needs, scholarships, or ongoing operating support.
- Castle Medical Center was named after Harold K.L. Castle's father, James. The Foundation has contributed more than \$8 million to Castle Medical Center.
- the Foundation has eliminated the requirement to fill out a Pre-Proposal Inquiry Form and has replaced it with an online inquiry, accessed through our website at www.CastleFoundation.org. Although this makes it easier to ask for support, the Foundation still must turn down many worthy requests because of limited funds.
