GENERAL INFORMATION: Game credentials, interviews, photographs and other Oregon State baseball information is available by calling Kip Carlson in the OSU Sports Information Office at (541) 737-7472. Press box space is limited at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field, and those planning on covering games are asked to notify the Sports Information Office at least 24 hours in advance.

Oregon State players are available for interviews before and after practice sessions and after games. Media are asked to arrange interviews through Carlson at least 24 hours in advance of the desired interview time.

POSTGAME SERVICES: Boxscores are available immediately after home games in the press box at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field. Play-by-play narratives are available upon request.

Writers may file stories from the press box, but may have to wait for phone lines used by radio crews. Postgame work space and phone lines are also available in the Sports Information Office in Gill Coliseum, located one block from Goss Stadium at Coleman Field.

WEBSITE: OSU's athletic department website is www.osubeavers.com, and it contains regularly updated baseball information.

RADIO: Press box space and a phone line for visiting radio crews are available at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field. Visiting radio crews are asked to notify the OSU Sports Information Office in advance.

TELEVISION: Several Oregon State games this spring may be televised, live and via tape delay, on Fox Sports Net.

PARKING: Parking is limited at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field. Oregon State campus parking permits are required on weekdays, but not weekends. Parking permits for campus visitors are available at the Parking Services Office located in Adams Hall, which is at the intersection of S.W. 15th Street and S.W. A Street. There are parking lots behind the left-field fence, next to the dormitories just south of Washington Way, and around Reser Stadium.
