1957 NAIA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

HOLIDAY BOWL • ST. PETERSBURG, FLA. • DEC. 21

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. – Kansas State Teachers College captured its first NAIA national championship with a narrow 27-26 victory against the Hillsdale College Dales in the 1957 Holiday Bowl.

The Gorillas snapped the Dales' 34-game winning streak and finished their season with an unblemished 11-0 record.

KSTC jumped out to a 20-0 lead then had to hold on in the game's final moments to secure the one-point victory.

Charles Norris had a pair of first-quarter touchdown runs and Paul Crandell hauled in a 17 yard TD pass from quarterback John Matous as KSTC struck for three scores in the initial period.

The Dales rallied with 13 points in the second quarter, then knotted the score at 20-20 on Walt Poe's 7-yard TD catch from quarterback Doug Maison.

Crandall put the Gorillas back in front with his second 17-yard TD grab from Matous and Bill Samuels booted the PAT for a 27-20 advantage.

Hillsdale's Earl O'Shaughnessy caught a 14-yard TD pass from Maison late in the fourth quarter, but Wayne O'Shaughnessy's potential game-tying PAT missed, leaving KSTC in front, 27-26.

The Dales successfully recovered an onside kick at the Gorillas' 46 yard line, but Gene Wayenberg sealed the KSTC victory when he intercepted a Maison pass in the end zone as time expired.

CAMELLIA BOWL • SACRAMENTO, CALIF. • DEC. 9

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – Kansas State College won its second NAIA Championship in five years with a hard-fought, 12-7, win against the Linfield College Wildcats in the 1961 Camellia Bowl at Hughes Stadium.

Bob Fulton put KSC in front on its first offensive play when he broke loose for a 64-yard scoring run.

Neither team scored again until the fourth quarter when KSC's Archie Ringgenberg returned an interception 89 yards to set up a one-yard plunge by Gary Snadon which put the Gorillas up 12-0.

The Wildcats had driven to the KSC 20 yard line, before Ringgenberg turned the game around with his interception.

Linfield countered with a scoring drive to trim the margin to 12-7 on Bernie Grant's 9-yard TD catch from quarterback Bill Parrish midway through the fourth quarter.

The Wildcats had a chance to take the lead late in the game, after driving to the KSC 40 with 1:22 left, but Parrish was sacked by Bruce Roach on fourth down to seal the victory.

BURLINGTON, N.C. – The Gorillas suffered their first NAIA championship game defeat on a blustery day in North Carolina, as the host Elon College Christians edged Pittsburg State, 3-0, for their second straight NAIA Division I crown.

The temperature was 30 degrees at kickoff with a northwest wind blowing 15-20 miles per hour. Turnovers and missed opportunities became the keys to the game.

Elon turned the ball over six times, including on its first two offensive possessions.

PSU couldn't cash in though, as Dave Hammons missed four field goals in the game (32, 29, 27, 47).

EC's Phil Renn scored the decisive points early in the fourth quarter when he booted a 23-yard field goal.

The Gorilla had a pair of opportunities to tie the score or go ahead in the final period.

Hammons missed a 47-yard field goal attempt with 10:27 to play in the game. After the Gorillas got the ball back, PSU drove to the EC 34-yard line, but Brent Smotherman's fumble gave the ball back to the Christians with 4:30 remaining.

Elon then successfully ran out the clock to claim the win.

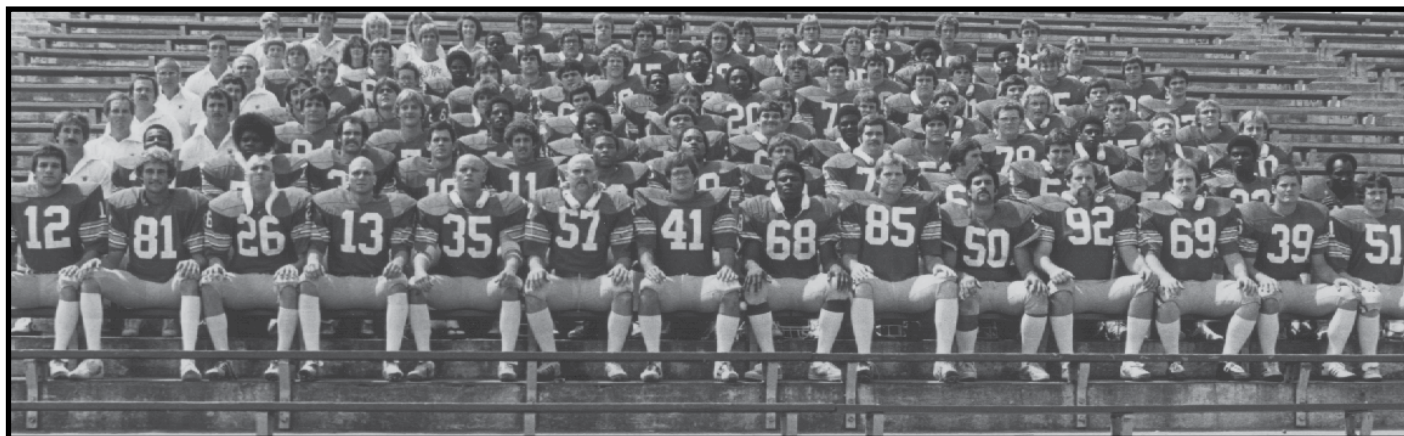

FLORENCE, Ala. — Pittsburg State University captured its first NCAA national championship by beating the Jacksonville (Ala.) State University Gamecocks, 23-6, at Florence, Ala.

Wide receiver Ronnie West, who was presented the Harlon Hill Award honoring the top athlete in Division II football the night before, caught a 17-yard TD pass from Brian Hutchins to put the Gorillas in front late in the first quarter.

Pitt State took a 13-6 lead to the intermission when Hutchins capped a 76-yard drive with a 13-yard run with 16 seconds remaining in the second quarter.

The Gorillas closed the door on the Gamecocks in the second half, when JSU QB Nickey Edmondson was forced out of the game with a leg injury in the third quarter.

Pitt State's Darren Dawson added a 10-yard touchdown run late in the third period, and James Jenkins booted a short 22-yard field goal midway through the fourth quarter to complete the scoring.

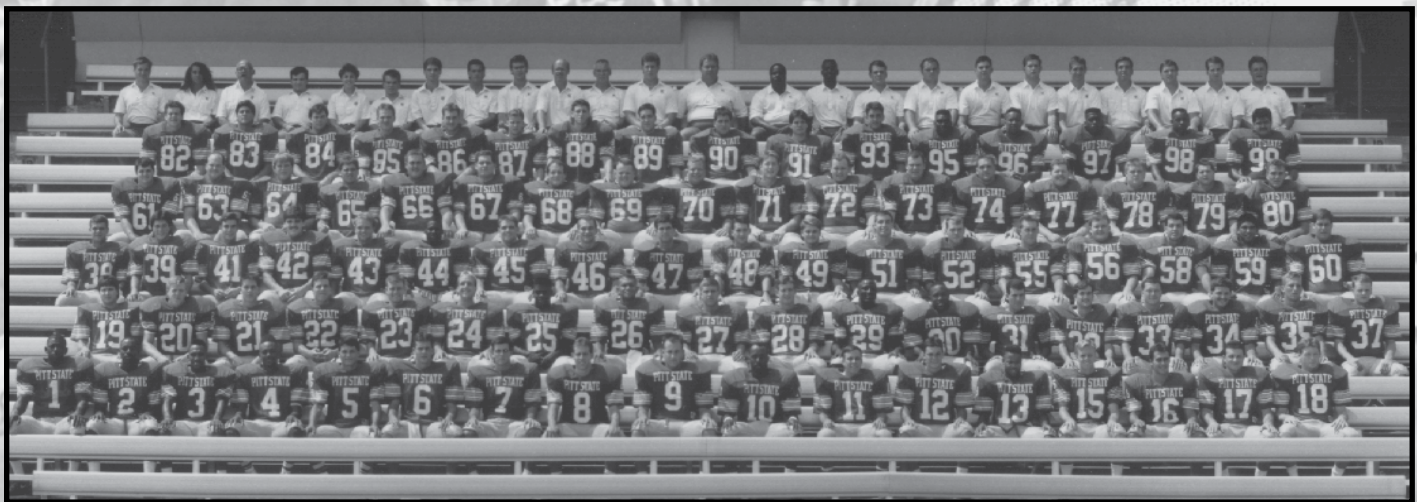

HISTORY

FLORENCE, Ala. — The Jacksonville (Ala.) State University Gamecocks played a game of keep-away with the Pittsburg State University Gorillas and then stopped a late drive to claim the 1992 NCAA Division II National Championship.

The Gamecocks (13-1-1) avenged a 23-6 loss to the Gorillas (14-1) in the 1991 title game by limiting Harlon Hill Award winner Ronald Moore to a season-low 83 yards rushing.

Pitt State built a 13-3 lead, but Jax State scored the game's final 14 points to win it.

Moore, who claimed the Hill Trophy as the National Player of the Year the night before the game, electrified the crowd by returning the opening kickoff 99 yards for a touchdown.

Ray Staten added a 21-yard TD grab from Brian Hutchins midway through the second quarter, before the Gamecocks closed within three points, at 13-10, on Danny Lee's 8-yard TD run late in the second stanza.

Jax State pushed in front on the opening drive of the third quarter, taking a 17-13 lead on Sean Richardson's 5-yard run.

The Gamecocks kept Pitt State's high-powered offense in check in the second half.

The Gorillas mounted a late drive, but Jax State held PSU on downs at the Gamecocks 22 yard line in the waning seconds to seal the victory.

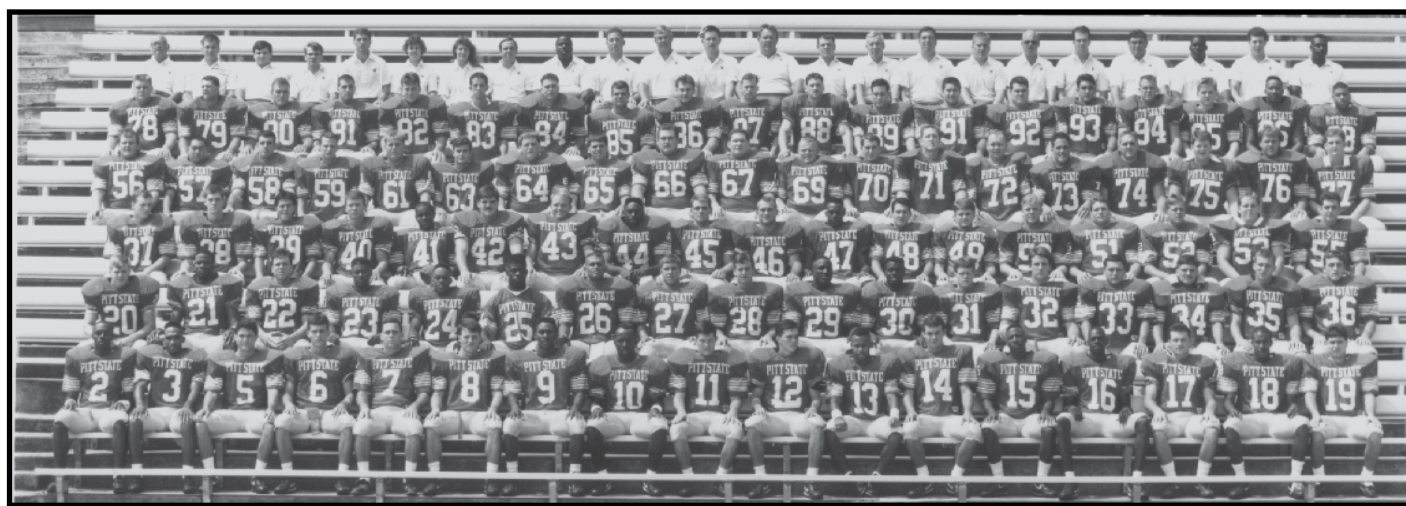

FLORENCE, Ala. – The University of North Alabama scored on its first offensive possession and stifled the Pittsburg State University offense to post a 27-7 victory and claim the 1995 NCAA Division II National Championship.

UNA (14-0) became the first Division II school to win the national title three years in a row, accomplishing the feat in front of its home crowd at Braly Stadium.

The Lions held PSU (12-1-1) to just 99 yards rushing and 176 yards of total offense for the game.

UNA built a 14-0 lead, then dealt PSU a damaging blow by adding a touchdown with five seconds left in the first half.

The Gorillas got on the board early in the fourth quarter when quarterback Jeff Moreland connected with Chris Hudson for a 15-yard scoring strike.

The Lions sealed the game when fullback Nate George capped a nine-play drive with a short plunge into the endzone with under a minute to play.

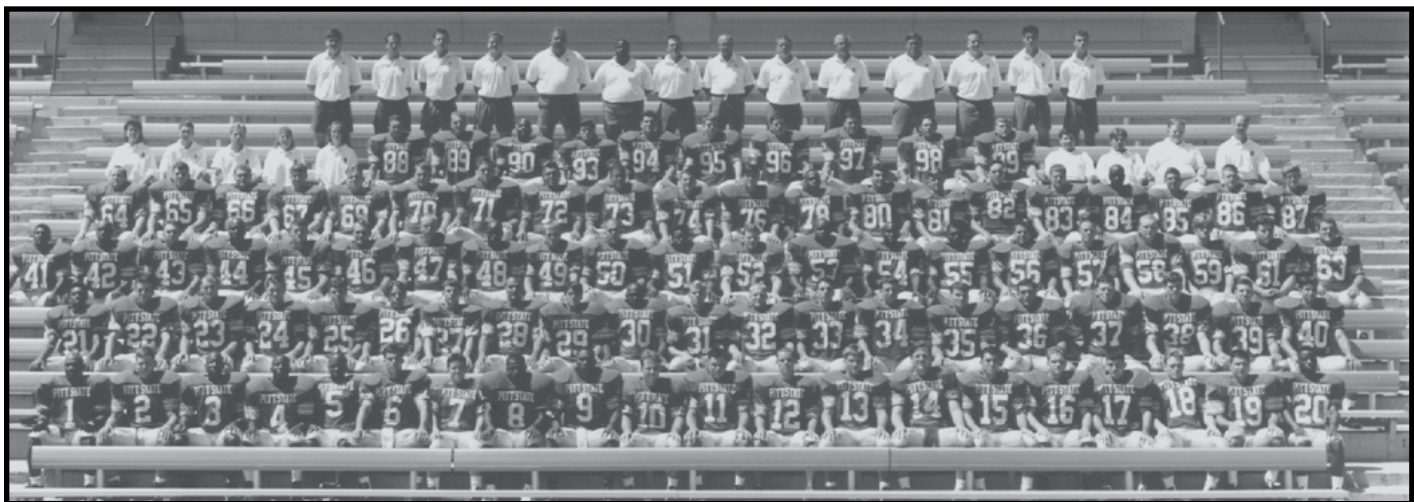

FLORENCE, Ala. – Fabian Walker rushed for a score and passed for two more to lead third-ranked Valdosta State University back from a 14-0 deficit and claim a 36-31 victory over top-ranked Pittsburg State University in the 2004 NCAA-II National Championship Game.

The Gorillas (14-1) jumped in front 14-0 on the Blazers (13-1), but were unable to shut the door on VSU.

Pitt State's Jimmie Taylor returned an interception 32 yards for a touchdown 56 seconds into the game, and Neal Philpot tossed a 10-yard TD pass to Jermaine Carpenter midway through the first period, staking the Gorillas to the double-digit lead.

The Blazers rallied to tie the game at 17-17 on Will Rhody's 27-yard field goal with three seconds remaining in the first half, and VSU scored 19 of the next 26 points in the second half to force the Gorillas to play from behind.

PSU's final offensive drive ended with an interception with 38 seconds remaining, allowing VSU to run out the clock.
