EXPLANATION

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF CYLC DECIDED TO SELL THE ORGANIZATION'S PROGRAM-RELATED ASSETS TO ENVISION EMI, LLC (SEE STATEMENT 7). CYLC COMMISSIONED A FAIRNESS OPINION AND RECEIVED THE OPINION THAT THE SALES PRICE (\$16,200,000) WAS FAIR AND THAT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SALE (\$10,000,000 IN CASH AT CLOSING, BALANCE PAID PURSUANT TO A SECURED INSTALLMENT NOTE (QUARTERLY PAYMENTS, PLUS INTEREST)) WERE FAIR. ENVISION ALSO ASSUMED ALL OF CYLC'S POST-CLOSING PROGRAM-RELATED LIABILITIES. THE SALE CLOSED ON DECEMBER 10, 2007. A PARTIAL LIQUIDATION WAS MADE TO DISTRIBUTE THE \$16,200,000 (SEE ATTACHED SCHEDULE OF THE DISTRIBUTIONS). CYLC, ON NOVEMBER 5, 2008, CHANGED ITS NAME TO GLOBAL YOUTH COUNCIL. CYLC IS IN THE PROCESS OF WINDING DOWN ITS AFFAIRS.
