THE GAME • Western Michigan will open its Mid-American Conference schedule with Toledo for the third-straight season. Both teams enter the contest 1-3 overall but only the Rockets have played a conference game, losing to Central Michigan, 52-31, on Sept. 8. Both teams captured their first wins of the season last week with WMU defeating Central Connecticut State, 51-14, and Toledo handing lowa State a 36-35 loss.

TELEVISION • The Bronco football program continues to gain regional and national notoriety through television exposre. Western Michigan is scheduled to play on live television at least six times this season. WMU will air on the ESPN family networks twice at home in 2007. The Broncos will have three games on Comcast Local and another on Comcast SportsNet. The game at Toledo will air on the Buckeye Cable Sports Network but on a delay in the BCSN's viewing area.

RADIO • This and all Western Michigan football games will be broadcast live on the Bronco Radio Network and its new flagship station, WZUU - 92.5 FM. Robin Hook (play-by-play) and Monty Porter (analysis) will have the call as they have together for the past nine seasons.

WEB SITE • WMU home football games (not televised by the ESPN family of networks) can be seen live via the official athletics web site (www.wmubroncos.com) by subscribing to Bronco Insider, which can be found on the home page of the site. You are able to listen to each Bronco football game on the Internet by signing up with Yahoo Sports through the link at the bottom of the home page. Live Stats are available for FREE for all Bronco home games by clicking the link atop the home football page. Live Stats

will also be available (at no cost) for the game against Toledo. Bronco Insider subscribers should also be able to watch the game live online thanks to Toledo sharing the stream via Rocket Vision.

SERIES IN BRIEF • Western Michigan trails the all-time series, 25-36-0, to Toledo. The Broncos snapped a five-game losing skid to the Rockets with a 31-10 win in the 2006 home season opener. WMU last tasted victory at the Glass Bowl in 1988, 31-9.

THE COACHES • Bill Cubit (Delaware, 1975) begins his third season as the head coach of Western Michigan. He is 15-12 overall, 9-2 at Waldo Stadium, at Western Michigan and led the Broncos to their first bowl game since 1988 last season. Tom Amstutz (Toledo, 1977) is in his seventh season as the head coach of Toledo football. Amstutz has a record of 51-28 with the Rockets during his tenure and has two MAC titles to his credit.

UP NEXT • The Broncos continue their MAC schedule with a showdown against 2005 MAC Champion, Akron. WMU held the Zips to minus-13 yards rushing in the 2006 season finale, a 17-0 win for Western Michigan. Akron opened its conference slate with a 27-20 victory over MAC East rival Kent State on Sept. 22. Western Michigan boasts an 11-3 record over Akron and is a perfect 6-0 against the Zips at Waldo Stadium. Akron is 0-3 in its last three meetings with the Broncos.

HAILING FROM THE 419 • Five members of the Western Michigan football team are Ohio natives but only was born and raised in Nortwest Ohio - Jim Laney. In fact, Laney is from Toledo and went to high school at St. Francis de Sales.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR • Robbie Krutilla and Branden Ledbetter find their names among the nation's elite in their respective positions. Krutilla has been named to a pair of preseason watch lists and Ledbetter has earned a spot on one. Krutilla is on the Rimington Trophy Watch List (the award for the nation's best center) as well as the Outland Trophy (the award for the nation's best interior lineman). It is the second year he has made it onto the Rimington preseason list.

Ledbetter finds himself on the John Mackey Award Watch List (the award for the nation's best tight end) for the first time. He was named the Mackey Tight End of the Week once last season after amassing 101 yards receiving against Miami.

Jim Laney was added to the Ray Guy Watch List, the award for the nation's top punter, after the third week of the 2007 season. Anthony Gebhart was nominated for the National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete Award, which will

CAPTAIN O' CAPTAIN • It looke as if for the first time in program history, Western Michigan football would not have season captains. This season began with the Broncos choosing game captains for its first two games.

LUCKY NUMBER SEVEN • Western Michigan is coming off back-to-back seasons with seven or more wins - the magic number to ensure bowl eligibility. Impressive as that is, another season with seven or more wins would only rank third all-time. The most consecutive seasons WMU has won seven or more games is six (1990-95). WMU went a combined 42-18-1 over that span. Ranking second is a span of four seasons (1997-2000) when the Broncos wen 31-15, won nine games (2000) for only the second time in program history and appeared in a two-straight MAC title games.

Another eight-win campaign would put this team in a class by itself for being the only one to capture backto-back seasons with eight wins or better.

POLL POSITION • Western Michigan was chosen by the Mid-American Conference News Media Association (MNMA) to not only win the West Division but take the conference crown home to Kalamazoo. WMU has steadily risen up the MAC West standings after finishing last in 2004 with a third-place finish in 2005 and a second-place finish last season.




